HEAVY RAIN HAS AFFECTED PORTIONS OF SOUTHEASTERN FLORIDA, MAINLY ACROSS MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND INTO SOUTHEASTERN SECTIONS OF BROWARD COUNTY. THE HEAVIEST RAIN OCCURRED OVER THE MIAMI METROPOLITAN AREA, WITH THE HIGHEST RAINFALL AMOUNTS OCCURRING SOUTH OF KENDALL DRIVE. RAINFALL AMOUNTS ACROSS THE REST OF SOUTH FLORIDA WERE GENERALLY LESS THAN AN INCH WITH ISOLATED 2 INCH AMOUNTS.

HERE ARE THE RAINFALL TOTALS FROM FRIDAY, OCTOBER 7TH AT 8AM THROUGH SUNDAY, OCTOBER 9TH AT 8AM. MOST OF THIS RAIN OCCURRED FRIDAY EVENING THROUGH SATURDAY EVENING.
