D. INLAND FLOODING...

GREENE...CATASTROPHIC FLASH FLOODING COUNTYWIDE. MOST LIKELY RECORD FLOODING ON THE SCHOHARIE CREEK AT PRATTSVILLE...BUT GAGE WAS LOST IN THE FLOOD.

SCHOHARIE...CATASTROPHIC FLASH FLOODING THROUGHOUT THE SCHOHARIE VALLEY. SCHOHARIE CREEK BROKE PREVIOUS RECORD FLOODS BY ONE TO TWO FEET AT THE GAGES THAT WERE NOT WASHED AWAY OR DAMAGED BY FLOODWATERS.

ULSTER...FLASH FLOODING IN MANY LOCATIONS. RECORD FLOODING ON THE ESOPUS CREEK AT COLD BROOK...THE RONDOUT CREEK AT ROSENDALE...AND THE HUDSON RIVER AT POUGHKEEPSIE. MAJOR FLOODING ON THE ESOPUS CREEK AT MOUNT MARION.

BERKSHIRE...FLASH FLOODING COUNTYWIDE. DEBRIS FLOW IN NORTH ADAMS. MAJOR FLOODING ON THE HOOSIC RIVER AT WILLIAMSTOWN. MODERATE FLOODING ON THE WEST BRANCH FARMINGTON RIVER AT NEW BOSTON...AND THE EAST BRANCH HOUSATONIC RIVER AT COLTSVILLE. MINOR FLOODING ON THE HOUSATONIC RIVER AT GREAT BARRINGTON.

BENNINGTON...FLASH FLOODING IN NUMEROUS LOCATIONS. RECORD FLOODING ON THE WALLOOMSAC RIVER AT BENNINGTON.

WINDHAM...CATASTROPHIC FLASH FLOODING COUNTYWIDE. RECORD FLOODING ON THE SAXTONS RIVER AT SAXTONS AND THE WILLIAMS RIVER AT ROCKINGHAM.

SCHENECTADY...FLASH FLOODING IN NUMEROUS LOCATIONS. MODERATE FLOODING ON THE MOHAWK RIVER AT SCHENECTADY.

LITCHFIELD...FLASH FLOODING COUNTYWIDE. MODERATE FLOODING ON THE HOUSATONIC RIVER AT FALLS VILLAGE AND MOST LIKELY AT GAYLORDSVILLE...BUT GAGE STOPPED FUNCTIONING BEFORE CREST.

ALBANY...FLASH FLOODING IN NUMEROUS LOCATIONS. MAJOR FLOODING ON THE HUDSON RIVER AT ALBANY. MODERATE FLOODING ON THE MOHAWK RIVER AT COHOES.

RENSSELAER...FLASH FLOODING IN SEVERAL LOCATIONS. MAJOR FLOODING ON THE HOOSIC RIVER AT EAGLE BRIDGE AND ON THE HUDSON RIVER AT TROY. MINOR FLOODING ON THE HUDSON RIVER AT WATERFORD.

DUTCHESS...FLASH FLOODING IN SEVERAL LOCATIONS. RECORD FLOODING ON THE HUDSON RIVER AT POUGHKEEPSIE. MAJOR FLOODING ON WAPPINGERS CREEK AT WAPPINGERS FALLS. MODERATE FLOODING ON THE TENMILE RIVER AT WEBATUCK.
