


The Great Lakes portal will be rolling out an updated webpage on Monday, July 27<sup>th</sup>. A brief tutorial for users will be available as a top news headline when the site becomes available. The site will be [weather.gov/greatlakes](http://weather.gov/greatlakes).

Here is a glimpse of what the new site will look like:



You can zoom into individual lakes by clicking the lake names above the map, or view the region as a whole under "All Lakes." Various weather element groups including hazards, wave height, wave period, wind speed, wind gust, weather, and temperature are available at three hour intervals by selecting the tabs immediately above the map. The time can be changed by clicking the arrows to the left or right of the map or using the circles underneath the map to jump to a specific time.

Finally, additional links are available below the map which includes much of the information that was formerly found on the blue left-hand menu of the old webpage.
