November Highlights:

- Cold and Snow, with plenty of both!!!
- Below normal temperatures were remarkably persistent during the month, with only a handful of days reporting near to above normal temperatures. As a result, all locations observed a top ten coldest November on record.
- While all areas received above normal precipitation and snowfall, the traditional snow belts were particularly hard hit. Gaylord and Sault Ste. Marie exceeded 5 feet of snow, all time monthly records for both locations!
