Overall, it was generally a normal June across the Denver area with slightly above normal temperatures and slightly above normal precipitation. Official rainfall at Denver was 2.23" which was 0.29" above normal. The average mean temperature was 59.0 degrees which was 0.8 degrees above normal.

The month was characterized by periods of severe weather as typically June is the most active month of the year. One outlier was a round of severe weather in the early morning hours on the 17th from Denver northward to the Wyoming. Several thunderstorms occurred with numerous reports of large hail. The largest hailstones ranged from 2.5" to 3.0" in diameter. The largest hail was centered around the Milliken and Wellington areas. Other areas had hailstones ranging from 1.0" to 2.0" in diameter.



Monthly Temperature Data (June)

- → Temperatures were near normal in Denver this month. Denver's mean temperature was 69.0°F, which was 0.8°F above normal.
- → The highest temperature for the month was 99°F on the 20th, and the lowest temperature was 47°F which occurred on the 3rd.
- → One temperature record was tied during the month.








Statewide Temperature June 2025








Statewide Precipitation June 2025






Statewide Precipitation June 2025


