Monthly Overview

November 2025

The first measurable snow of the season, at Denver, didn't occur until November 29th. This was the 2nd latest on record for Denver going back to 1882.

Temperatures were above normal in November with well below normal precipitation across most of the area except for the east central Plains of Colorado.

Official rainfall at Denver (measured at DIA) was 0.09" which was 0.55" below normal.

Official snowfall at Denver was 0.2" which was 7.1" below normal.

The average mean temperature at Denver was 45.1 degrees which was 5.7 degrees above normal.





Monthly Temperature Data (November)

- Temperatures were much above normal in Denver this month. Denver's mean temperature was 45.1°F, which was 5.7°F above normal.
- The highest temperature for the month was 83°F on the 2nd, and the lowest temperature was 8°F which occurred on the 20th.
- A new record high of 83°F occurred on the 2nd which also was a new record high for the month as well.

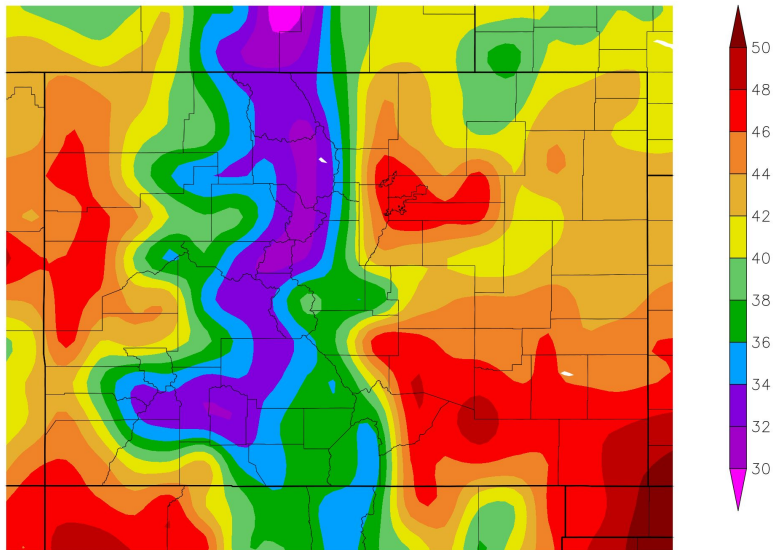

Statewide Temperature November 2025

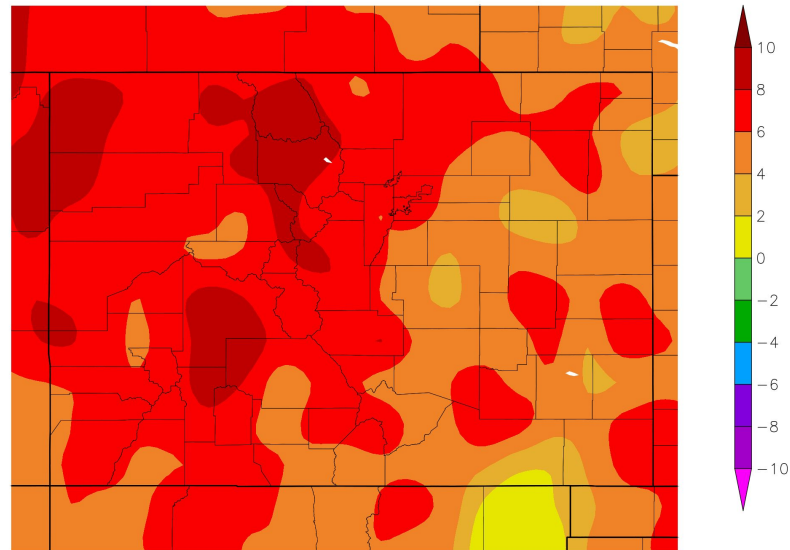
Temperature (F)

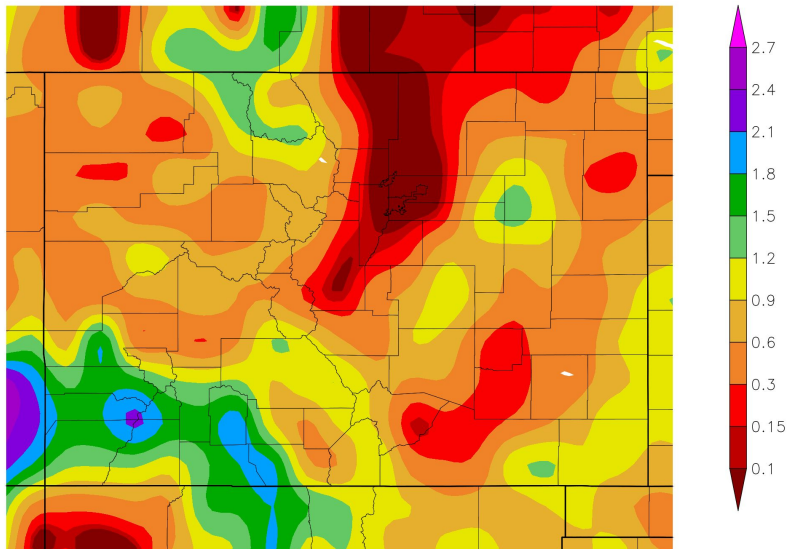

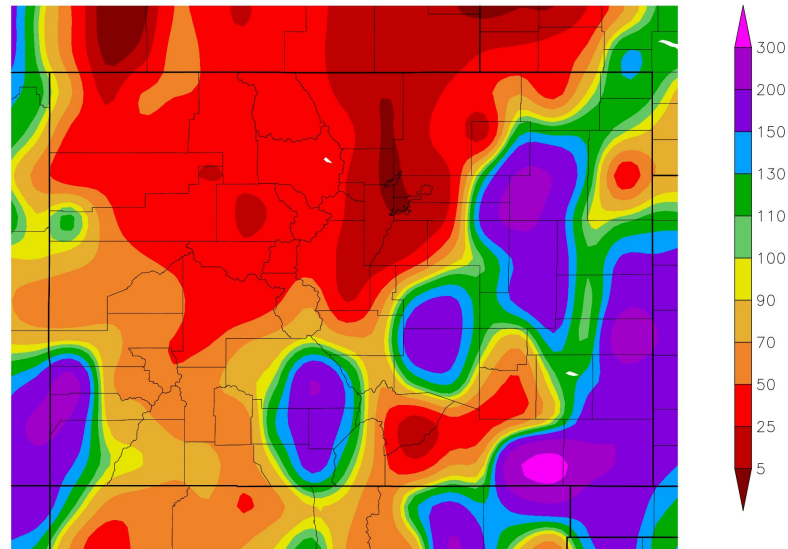
Precipitation (in)

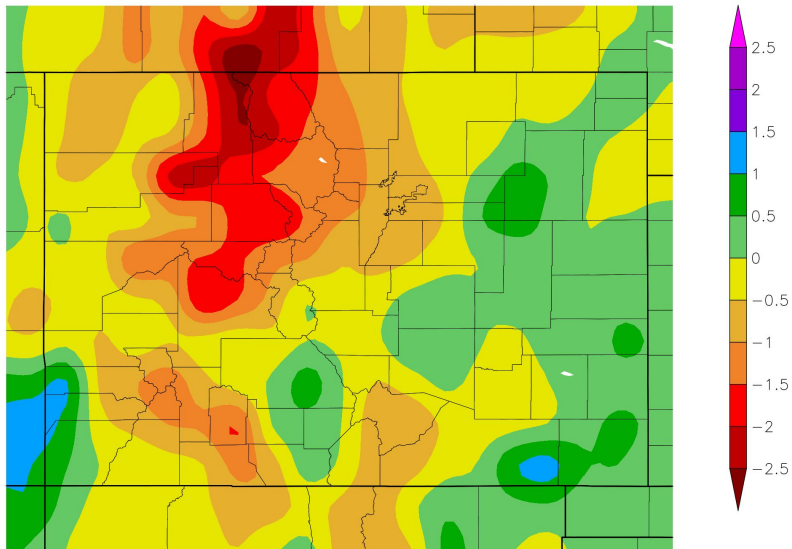
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Statewide Precipitation November 2025

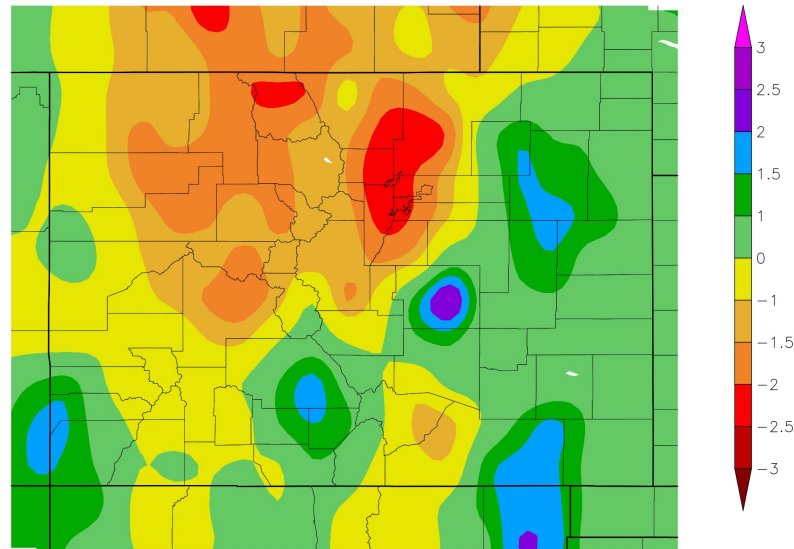
Departure from Normal Precipitation (in)

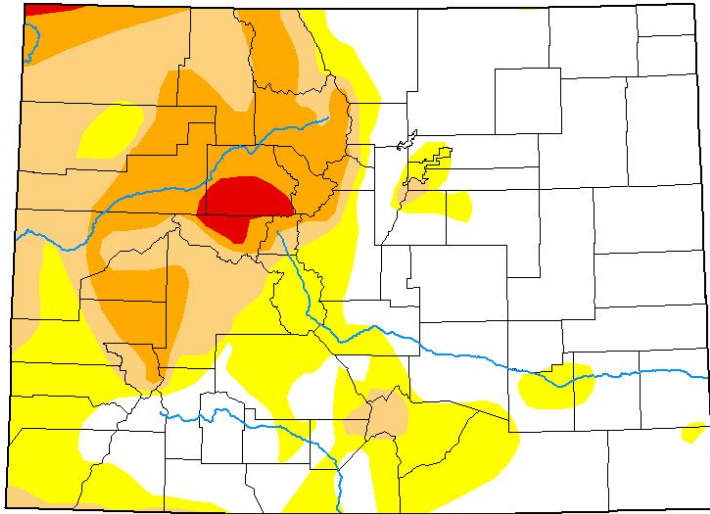

Drought Conditions Colorado

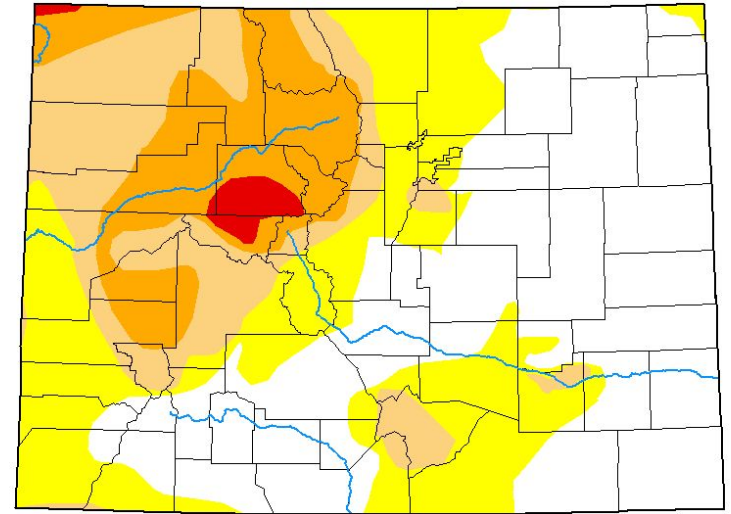
October 28. 2025

Drought conditions continued over the higher terrain, especially across Grand, Jackson and Summit counties. Elsewhere conditions changed very little from late October.



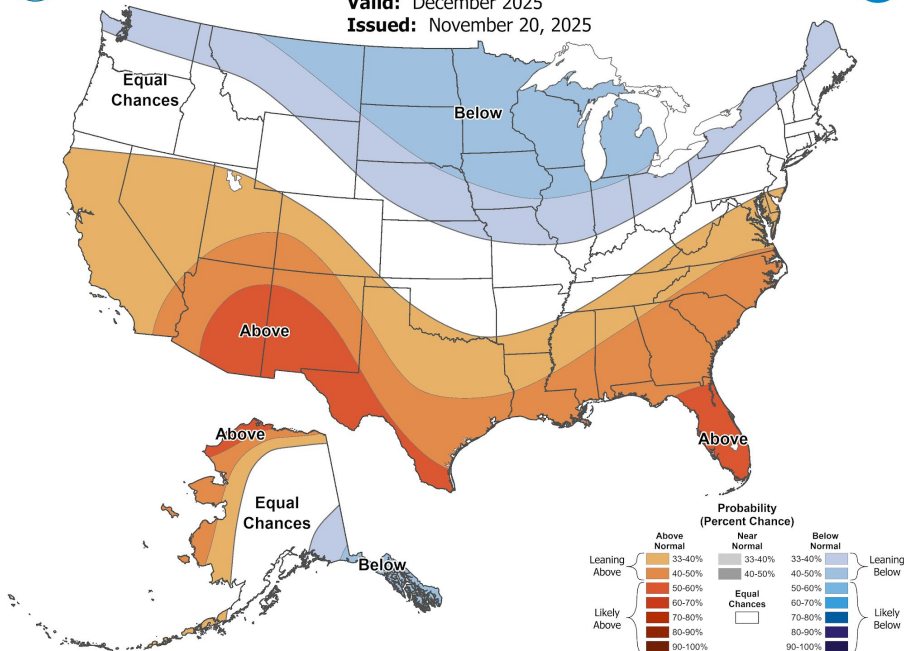


30 Day and 90 Temperature Outlooks



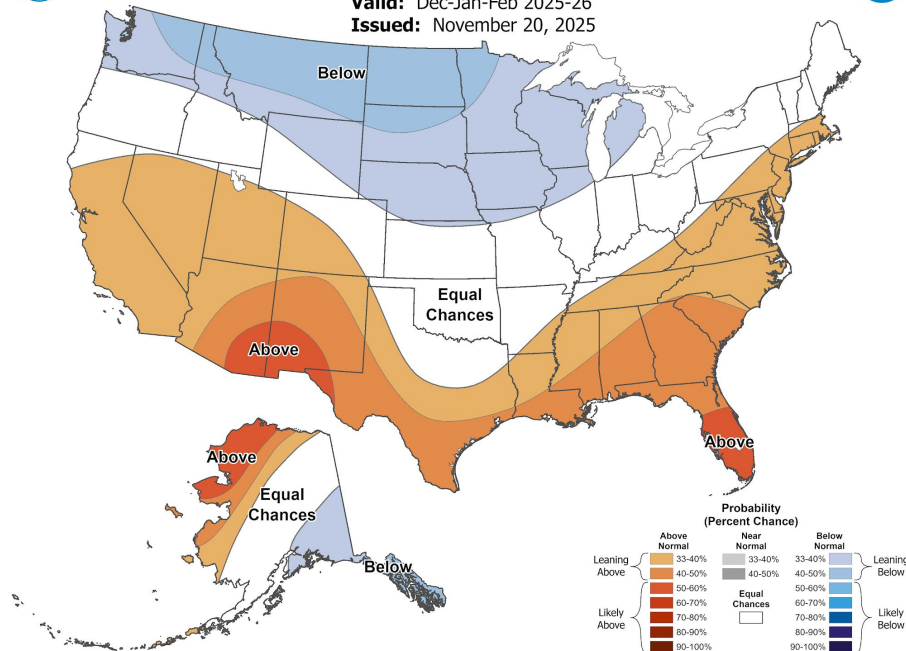

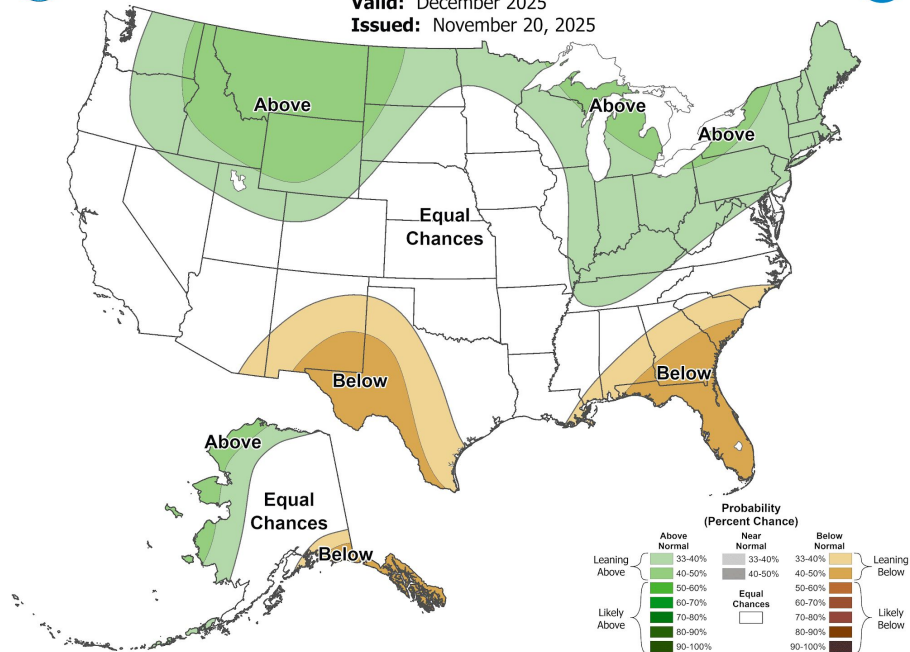


30 Day and 90 Day Precipitation Outlooks
