


Approaching Winter Storm

Issued 3 PM, November 16, 2015

A Winter Storm will move across the region Tonight and Tuesday... bringing snow to Colorado. Strong Winds will bring Blizzard conditions and Heavy Snow to much of Northeast Colorado and the Palmer Divide Tonight into Tuesday.



Key Points

- Snow begins:
 - Mountains and mountain valleys – Snow increasing this evening
 - In/near Foothills & I-25 Urban Corridor – Late this afternoon/early evening
 - Eastern Plains – This evening
- Main threats will be low visibility in falling, blowing, and drifting snow. Some areas may experience heavy snowfall
- Road closures will be possible on the plains east of Denver along with potential of blizzard conditions
- Worst conditions Tonight through Tuesday morning
- Late Afternoon rush & Tuesday AM rush may be slow
