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High pressure over the Gulf of Mexico, interacting with a low pressure system and associated cold front moving through Texas, produced dangerous conditions in the near shore waters of South Padre Island on Christmas Day. Strong southerly winds around 20 knots and rough seas of 5 to 7 feet were observed for much of the day; the resulting longshore current swept a swimmer to his death on the north end of South Padre Island.

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
