...DOLLY CONTINUES TO CHURN IN THE CENTRAL GULF OF MEXICO...

.AT 100 AM CDT...0600Z...THE CENTER OF TROPICAL STORM DOLLY WAS LOCATED NEAR LATITUDE 23.2 NORTH...LONGITUDE 93.3 WEST OR ABOUT 320 MILES...515 KM...SOUTHEAST OF BROWNSVILLE TEXAS.

DOLLY IS MOVING TOWARD THE WEST NEAR 17 MPH...28 KM/HR. A TURN TO THE WEST-NORTHWEST IS EXPECTED LATER TODAY WITH A DECREASE IN FORWARD SPEED...FOLLOWED BY A TURN TO THE NORTHWEST ON WEDNESDAY. ON THIS TRACK...THE CENTER OF DOLLY SHOULD BE VERY NEAR THE WESTERN COAST OF THE GULF OF MEXICO ON WEDNESDAY.

MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS ARE NEAR 50 MPH...85 KM/HR...WITH HIGHER GUSTS. DOLLY IS EXPECTED TO STRENGTHEN INTO A HURRICANE PRIOR TO LANDFALL.

TROPICAL STORM FORCE WINDS EXTEND OUTWARD UP TO 200 MILES... 325 KM FROM THE CENTER.

AN AIR FORCE HURRICANE HUNTER PLANE REPORTED A MINIMUM CENTRAL PRESSURE OF 999 MB...29.50 INCHES.

DRY WEATHER WILL PREVAIL TONIGHT. SOME OF THE OUTER RAIN BANDS MAY MOVE INTO DEEP SOUTH TEXAS LATER THIS MORNING. MORE WIDESPREAD HEAVY RAINFALL IS EXPECTED TO START TONIGHT CONTINUING INTO WEDNESDAY AND WEDNESDAY NIGHT.
