


# New Enhanced Mountain Point Forecast

At the National Weather Service in Burlington, VT we are always looking for new ways to improve our forecast services on the internet for our users. Today we are pleased to announce a new addition to our suite of recreational forecasts, the **Enhanced Mountain Point Forecast**.


