




X An X inside this box indicates that no flooding occurred within this hydrologic service area.

November 2014 was a fairly quiet month with below normal precipitation across the county warning area. There were no flooding concerns in our CWA. We had one Flood Watch issued for November 26-27. Heavy rain fell over two days totaling one to two inches across our CWA. The rivers had moderate responses, but no rivers were even close to flood stage. Most of the forecast area had 2-4" of rain throughout the entire month.


