Subject: Expansion of River Forecast and Warning Services for the
 Cuyahoga River at Jaite, OH

On Wednesday, December 1st, 2023, the National Weather Service (NWS) will begin providing forecast and warning services during times of high water along the Cuyahoga River near Jaite, OH. The NWS location identifier (NWSLI) for this location is JAIO1. The location for the river forecasts is the USGS gauging station located 1.5 miles south of Sagamore Hills, OH in the Cuyahoga Valley National Park.

River forecast information will be provided by the Ohio River Forecast Center (OHRFC) during times of high water. Action stage will be defined at 10 feet, minor flood stage at 12 feet, moderate flood stage at 18 feet, and major flood stage at 20 feet.
