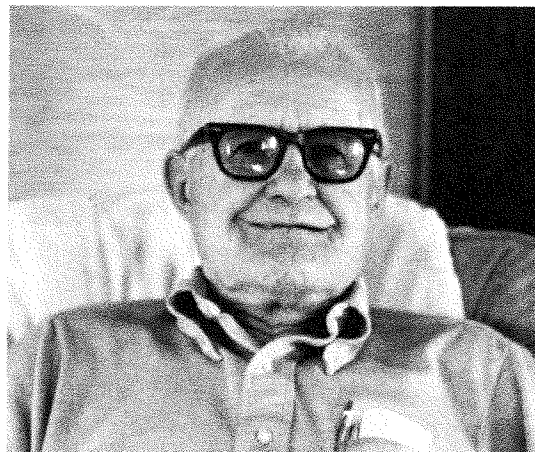

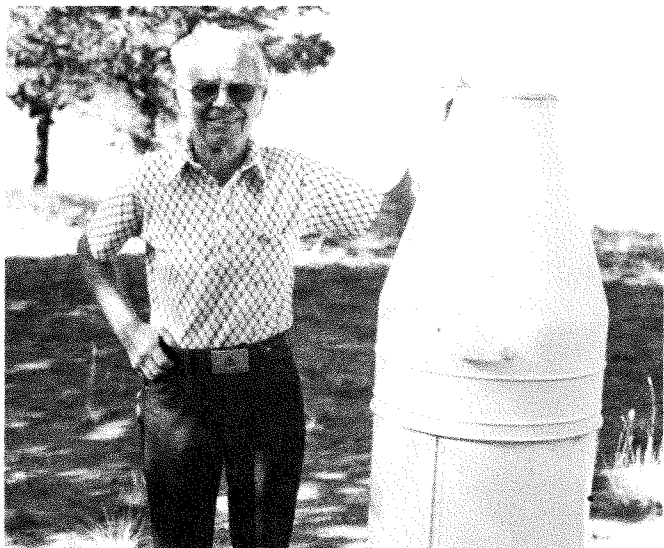

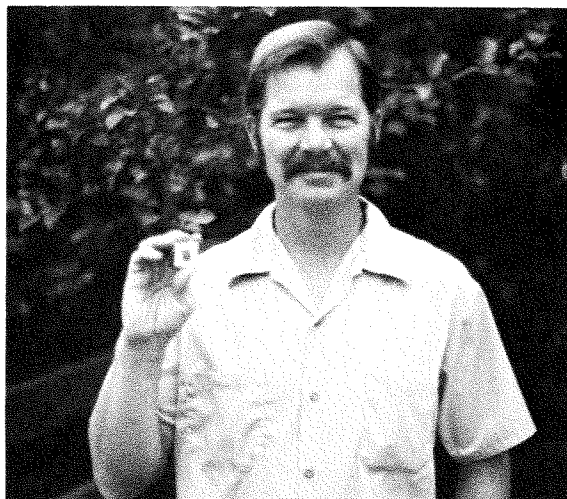

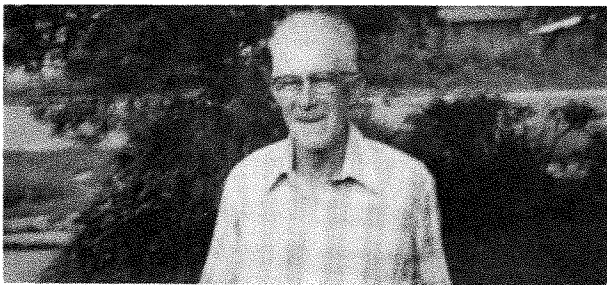
A 10-year Service Award is displayed by Bill Cox at Tacoma in southwestern Colorado. The award was presented by CPM Bill Tate.

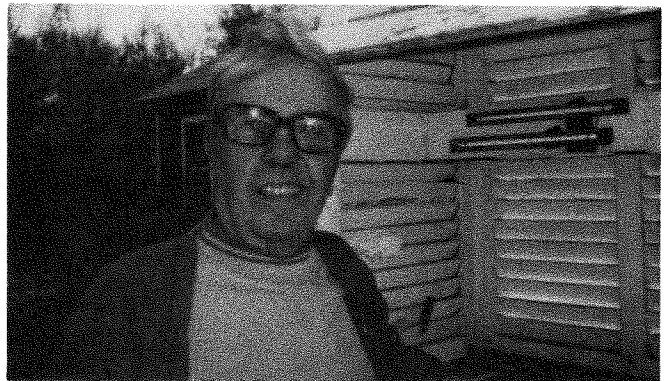

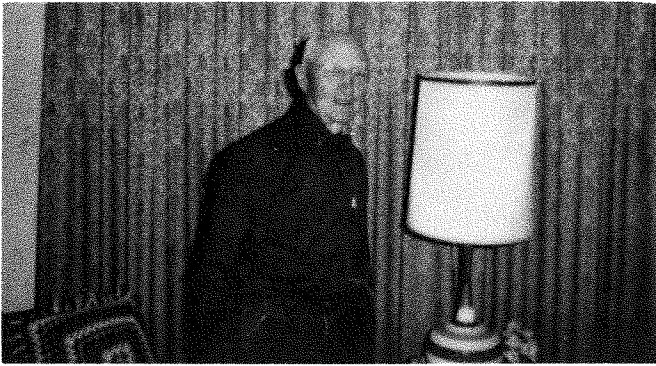

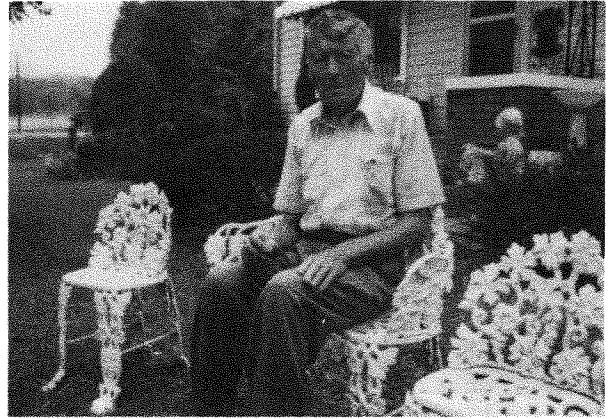

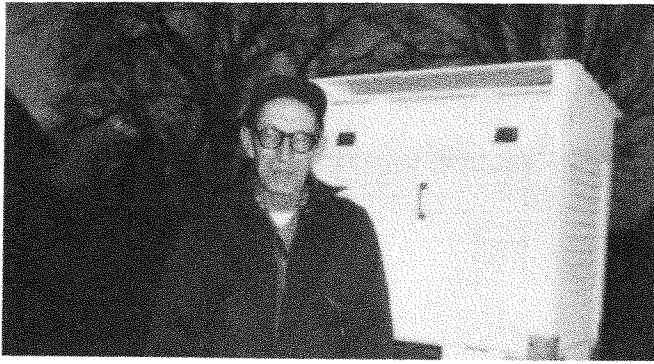

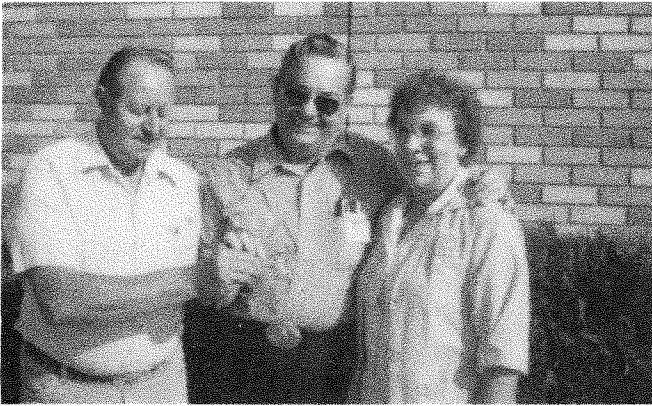

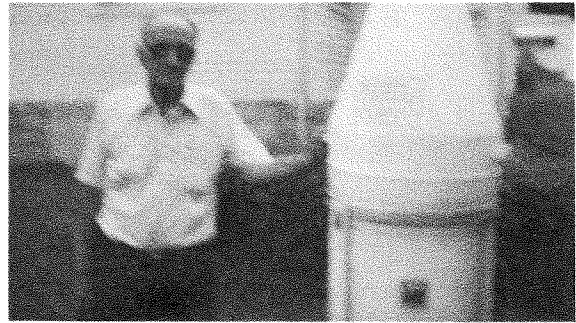

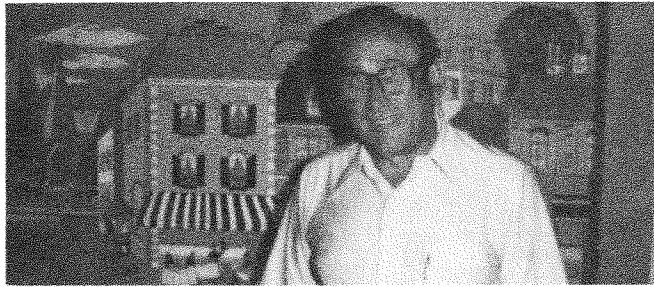

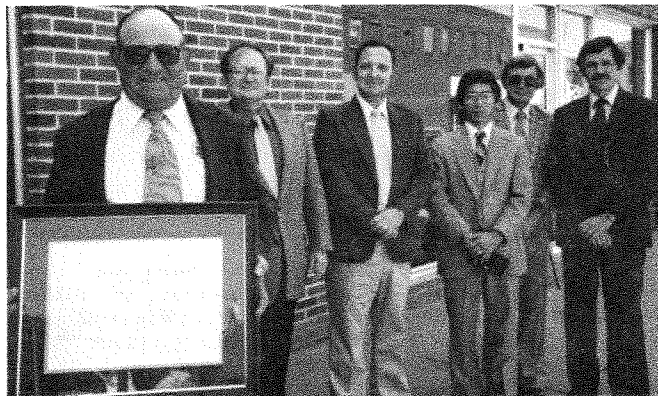

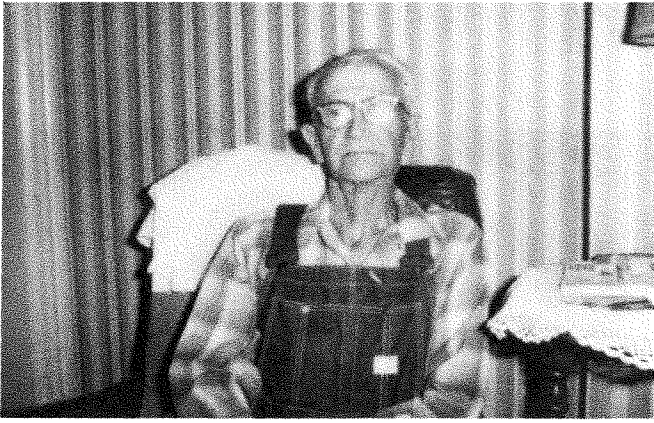

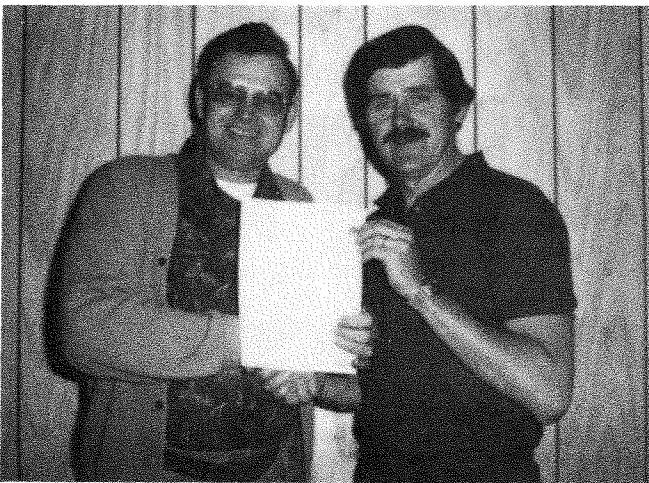
