


Snow Continuing Today!


Forecast Snowfall



Valid Ending Thursday March 17th, 2016 at 7 AM CDT



- Rain changing to snow area-wide
- More accumulation through the afternoon.
- Road Conditions poor on untreated roads

Winter Storm Warning → *Travel Discouraged*




Rain Causing Flooding!






Snow Ends Early Thurs. Morning
