

Winter Storm Watch




- A spring storm will bring heavy rain to the Northland today (Tuesday)
- Late tonight, rain will change to snow across the tip of the MN Arrowhead
- Wednesday morning, rain changes to snow elsewhere with heavy snowfall rates likely
- Snow continues into Wednesday night, lingering across the south shore Thursday




Rain to Snow Late Tonight

4am Wednesday Morning






Change to Snow Wed. Morning






Snow Ends Wed. Night


Lingering South

Valid Ending Thursday March 17th, 2016 at 7 PM CDT






Proper Snowfall Measurement

- ✓ Measure in a flat, open area
- ✓ Take an average from a few different measurements



mPING app

- Use the free mPING app to report the precipitation type (rain, snow, or a mix)
- Available for iPhone/iPad and Android devices
- Search “mPING”

Conclusion
