


# Fourth of July Weather Facts for Waterloo



## Other Climate Factoids

The Top 5 Hottest Fourths since 1895 (by daily high temperature) include:

1. 109 1911
2. 100 2012 and 1901
4. 96 1982
5. 95 1990, 1989, 1977, 1966, and 1907

The Top 5 Coolest Fourths since 1895 (by daily high temperature) include:

1. 62 1915
2. 64 1967
3. 65 1956 and 1909
4. 66 1972

The Top 5 Hottest Fourths since 1895 (by daily average temperature) include:

1. 91.0 degrees in 1911
2. 87.0 degrees in 2012 and 1901
4. 85.0 degrees in 1977
5. 83.0 degrees in 1999

The Top 5 Coolest Fourths since 1895 (by daily average temperature) include:

1. 53.5 degrees in 1967
2. 57.0 degrees in 1972 and 1915
4. 60.0 degrees in 1909
5. 61.0 degrees in 1997

The Top 5 Wettest Fourths since 1895 include:

1. 2.71" 2002
2. 1.71" 1930
3. 1.25" 1994
4. 0.98" 1973
5. 0.96" 1963

Measurable rain has fallen in Waterloo on the Fourth of July in 44 out of 120 years on record going back to 1895 – giving the chance of occurrence at 37%.
