



# Hazard Summary


## Heavy Rain Possible This Weekend



Rainfall today has ranged from 0.5" to 1.5" with highest amounts over Metro Detroit

Tonight/Sunday: Additional Rain Lifts into the area north of a surface low

**Areal Flood Watch in effect through Sunday afternoon (counties in green)**




# Hazard Summary

## Flooding Potential



WPC 24-Hour Forecast Rainfall Totals (Tonight and Sunday)



1 to 2" additional possible through Sunday afternoon



# Weather Details

## Tonight and Sunday



### What

- Rainfall will continue tonight through Sunday
- **Greatest Threat:** Heavy Rainfall and Flooding
- 1 to 2 additional inches are possible through Sunday, bringing totals since Saturday to 1 to 3 inches
- Flooding of flood-prone areas and ponding on area roadways is likely
- Rises on area rivers are expected

### When

- Through Sunday afternoon

### Where

- Flood Watch in effect for I-69 counties southward plus Sanilac County
- Rainfall will taper off overnight for the Tri-Cities and northern Thumb resulting in less of a flooding threat

### Forecast Confidence

- High in widespread rainfall, medium in flood potential

# Additional Weather Details



## Tonight and Sunday

- Temps will plummet into the 40s and 50s this evening behind the cold front
- High temps on Sunday will only be in the upper 40s and low 50s
- Northeast winds will gust in excess of 30 MPH at times on Sunday
- Small craft advisories are in effect on the Great Lakes tonight and Sunday with Gale Warnings for Saginaw Bay
- The strongest winds on Sunday will be in Bay and northern Saginaw Counties, downwind of Saginaw Bay
