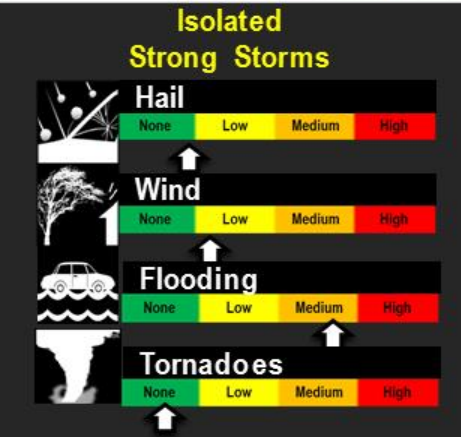
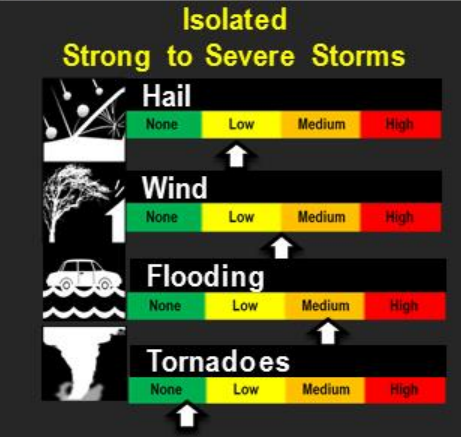
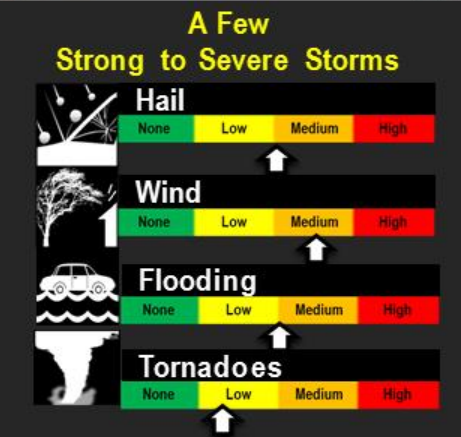
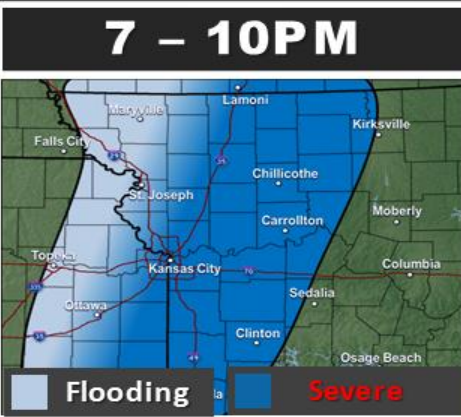
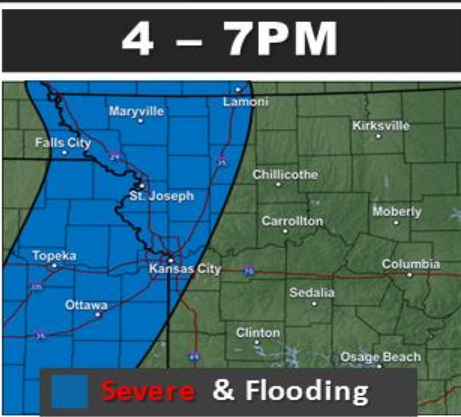


# Severe Storms Possible This Evening

- Storms are expected to develop from northwestern Missouri back through eastern Kansas between 4PM-6PM today and quickly form into a SW-NW oriented line that will progress quickly east.
- Early on, individual storms may be capable of producing hail up to quarter size however, the main threat will quickly become damaging winds . Some storms capable of producing winds greater than 60mph will be possible. An isolated tornado also cannot be ruled out.
- Otherwise, lightning and heavy rain will be likely tonight with many areas receiving 1 to 3 inches of rain. Heavy rain may lead to minor river flooding as well as flash flooding in low-lying and flood prone areas. Moderate rain behind the initial squall line will continue into the overnight hours continuing the possible areal flooding from small creeks and rivers
