Only 11 out of the 46 counties in the Fort Worth County Warning Area experienced drought conditions in the month of November. Up to 4 to 5 inches of rain fell in Lamar, Parker, Wise, and Tarrant County which ended the drought for these counties. However, little rain fell across the western portions of the area and drought persisted and even worsened to the extreme category for Palo Pinto, Stephens, and Young County.
