





Winter Storm Briefing

Thursday, December 10, 2015



- **Very breezy Thursday night** as cold front pushes into region. Wind gusts to 50 mph along front. Will subside by mid-morning Friday.
- **Snow begins north of I-70 overnight**, and **shifts further south throughout Friday**...mainly along and behind cold front
- **Area of heavy snowfall sets up along SE Utah to Steamboat Springs axis Friday evening to Saturday morning. Uncertainty on where exactly this will set up.** Could drop **4 to 6"** in valleys, **6-12+"** for western CO and SE Utah high mountain areas.
- **Snowfall decreasing from the west Saturday.** Improvement reaching continental divide by late Sat. night.




Forecast Snowfall
