






Winter Weather Impact Summary







Freezing Rain, Sleet, and Strong Winds Expected Monday Afternoon – Monday Night

Expected Impacts

Hazardous Travel - Very Slow Speeds

Significant Ice Accumulations
Wind Gusts to 50 MPH

Power Outages

Possible Impacts

Long Duration Power Outages

Hazardous Travel

Sleet and Ice Accumulations
Wind Gusts to 50 MPH

Scattered Power Outages

Possible Impacts

Significant Ice Accumulations

Power Outages

Immediate – Life Saving Action	Extremely Life Threatening Everything Will be Shut Down Possibly for Days or Weeks
Be Prepared – Major Actions	Expect Dangerous Conditions Expect Major Disruption of Normal Activities
Be Aware – Minor Actions	Caution – Especially When Travelling Plan to be Inconvenienced
Little to No Action	Little to No Impact on Daily Life Plan on Minor Inconvenience


Will This Happen? Near Certain Better than 50/50 Chance Unlikely



Potential Ice Totals



For Monday and Monday Night, December 28, 2015



0.25 - 0.50 Inches of Ice

Rapid Ice Accumulation Possible Monday Afternoon and Monday Evening

Power Outages Likely

Due to Icing on Power Lines and Trees Strong Winds to Contribute to Outages

Dry Monday Morning Commute Hazardous Afternoon Commute

Sleet Expected At Onset


Mixing With and Changing to Freezing Rain

Monday Afternoon and Evening, December 28, 2015



East Winds 20-30 MPH Wind Gusts 40-50 MPH

Combination of Ice and Strong Winds

Could Lead to Significant Interruptions in Power




When Winter Weather is Expected



December 28, 2015

Weather Radar Forecast Early Monday Afternoon



Starting	Sleet/Freezing Rain Begins by Late Morning Across Southern Lower MI
Worst Weather Expected	All of Lower Michigan: Noon Monday – Midnight Monday Night
Ending	For Most of Lower Michigan: Freezing Rain to Rain Overnight
Commutes Affected	Monday Afternoon Commute
