

When	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Time of Greatest Risk for Storms: 6 PM Wednesday – 2 AM Thursday
Where	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Greatest Risk: Southern Lower Michigan
Forecast Confidence	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Confidence of Storm Development: High• Confidence for Severe Weather: Medium



Ways To Help Us Get The Word Out




- ✓ Severe Thunderstorm Warnings are issued for storms that could injure people and should be taken seriously
- ✓ Whether caused by straight-line winds or a brief tornado, significant wind damage will be possible in any storm
- ✓ This will be a day trees could fall on homes, so encourage people to go to a storm shelter/basement
- ✓ Recreational Activities: Boaters, swimmer, campers should move to shelter early. Storms will be moving fast
