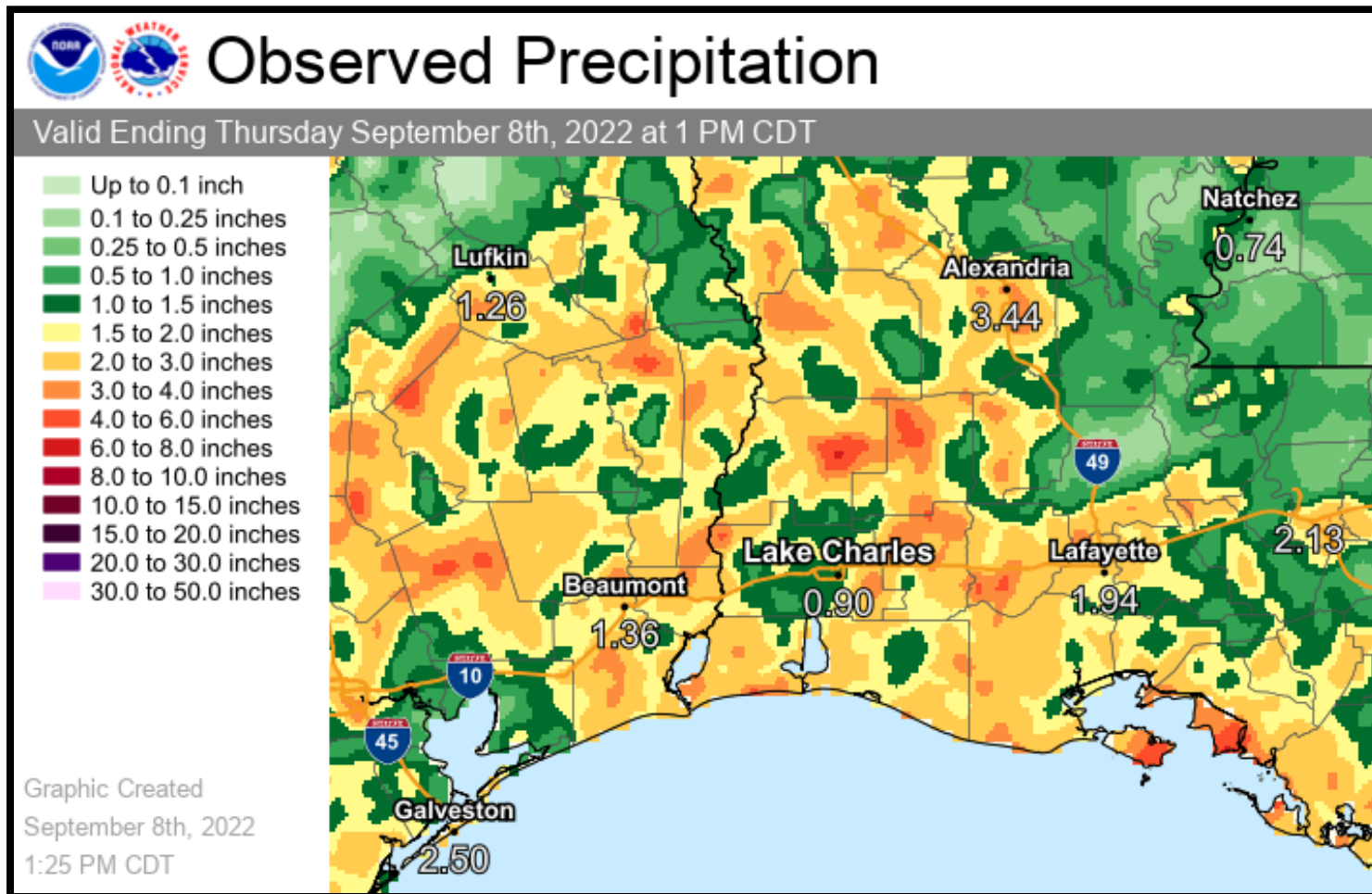

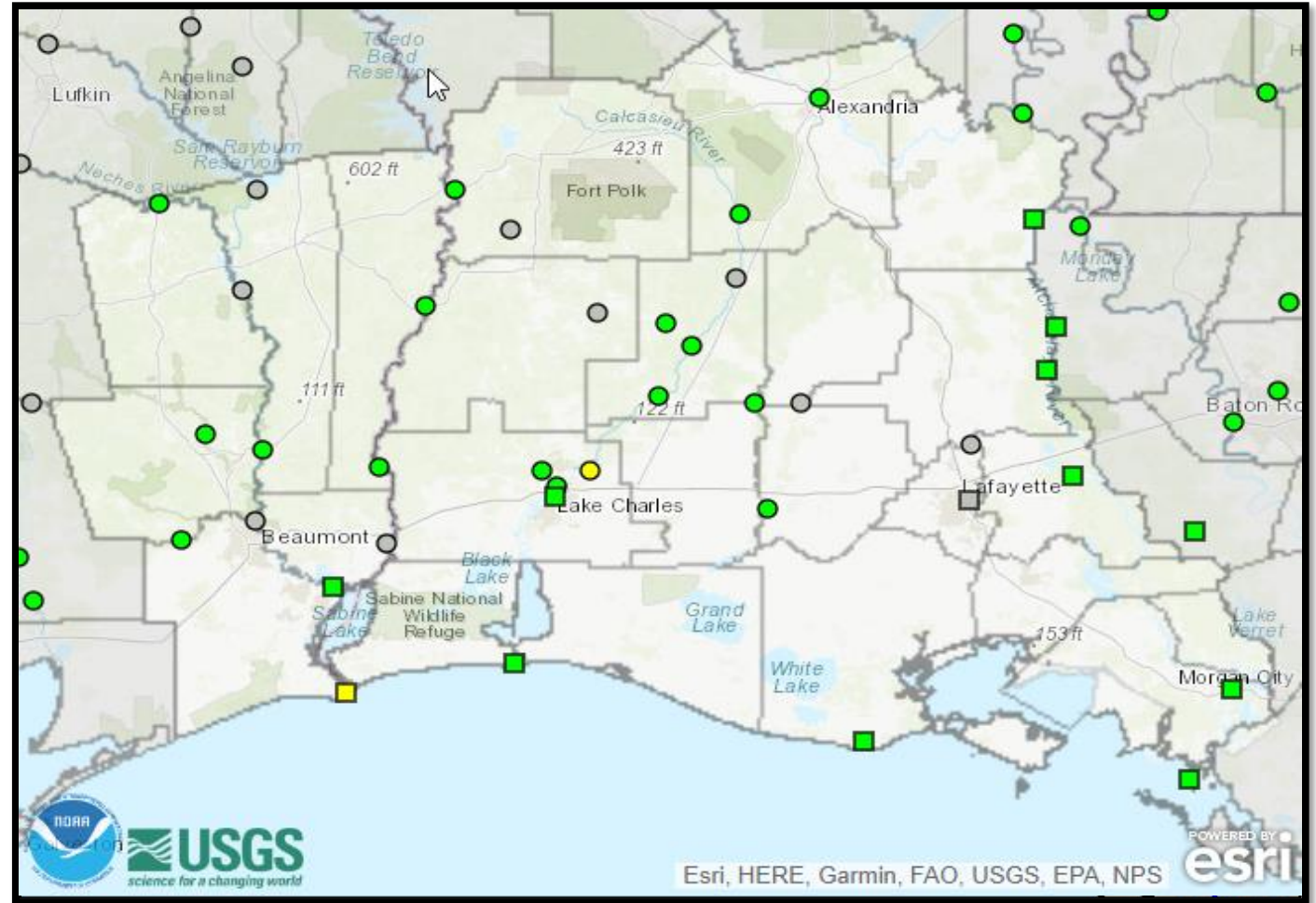
A few showers and thunderstorms will be possible as we head into the weekend. Temperatures decrease slightly at the start of next week as a “cold” front ushers in drier air.

White Oak Park along the Calcasieu River has remained near flood, but flooding is not anticipated. Otherwise, no other rivers or points are in flood.

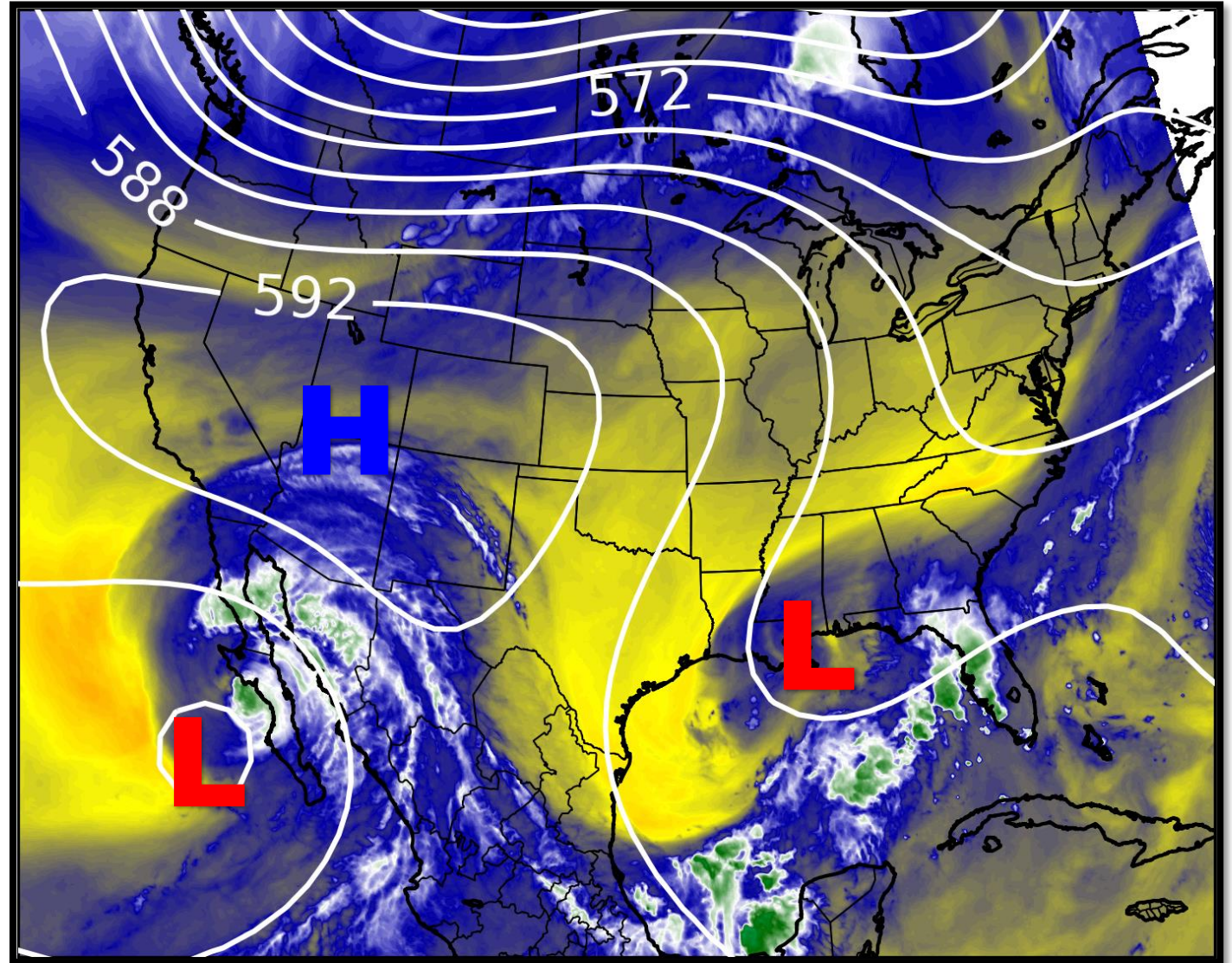


Upper Level Steering Patterns

Skies were mostly clear this morning, expect for a couple of spots that saw some patchy fog. Temperatures were in the upper 60s to low 70s and winds were calm.

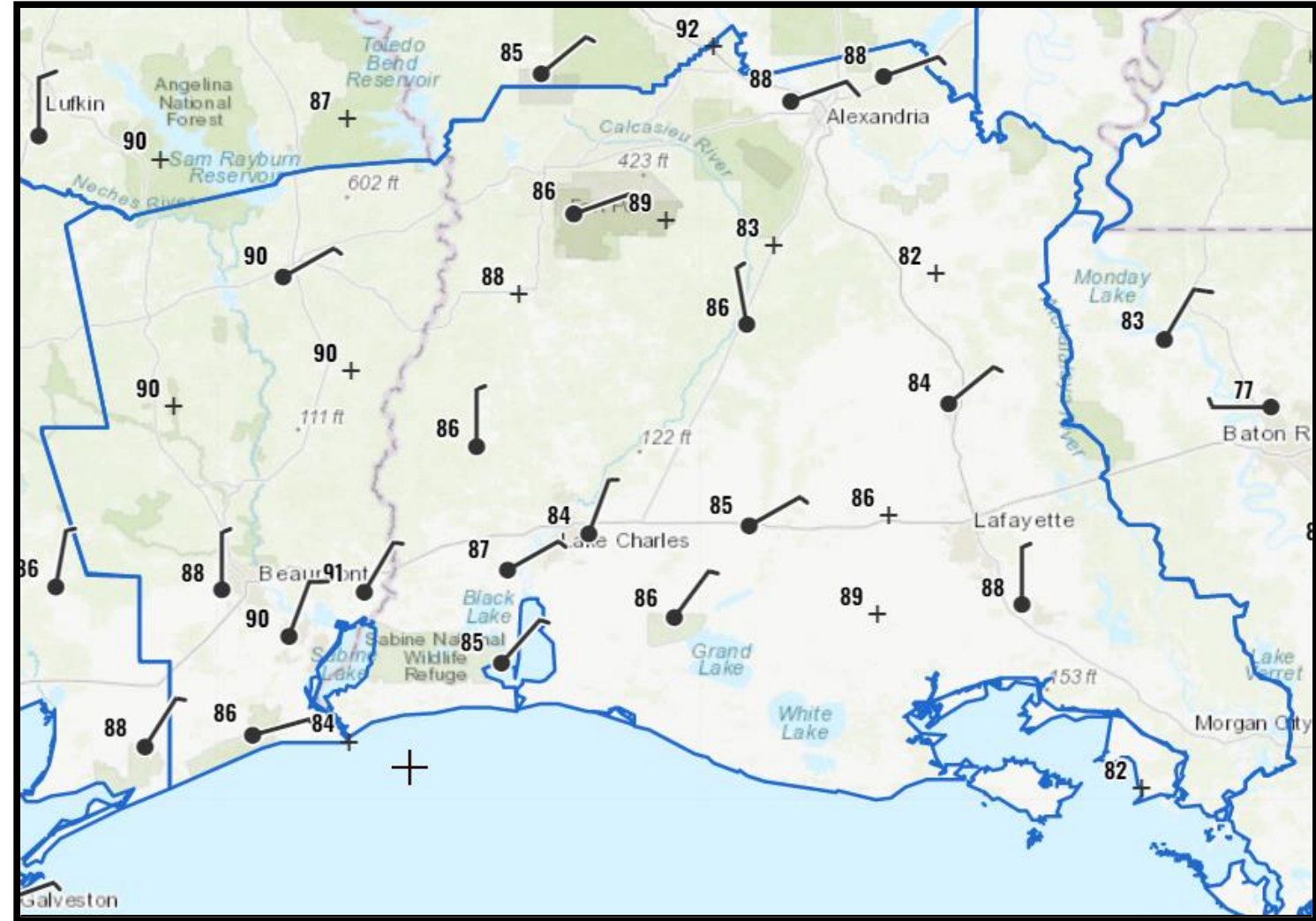


2 pm Weather Observations

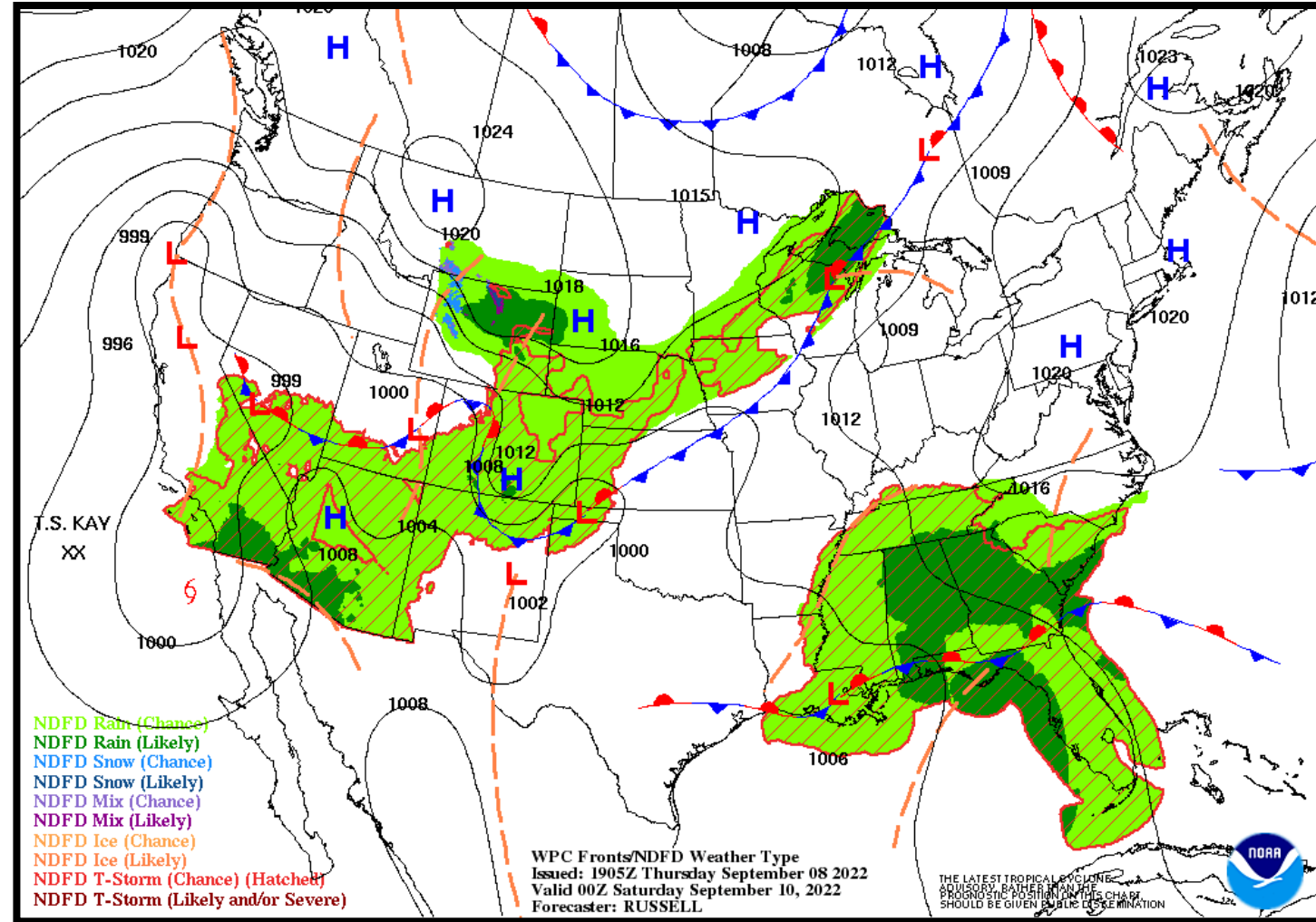
Partly cloudy skies and north-northeasterly winds are ongoing across the region. Temperatures are in the upper 80s to near 90.

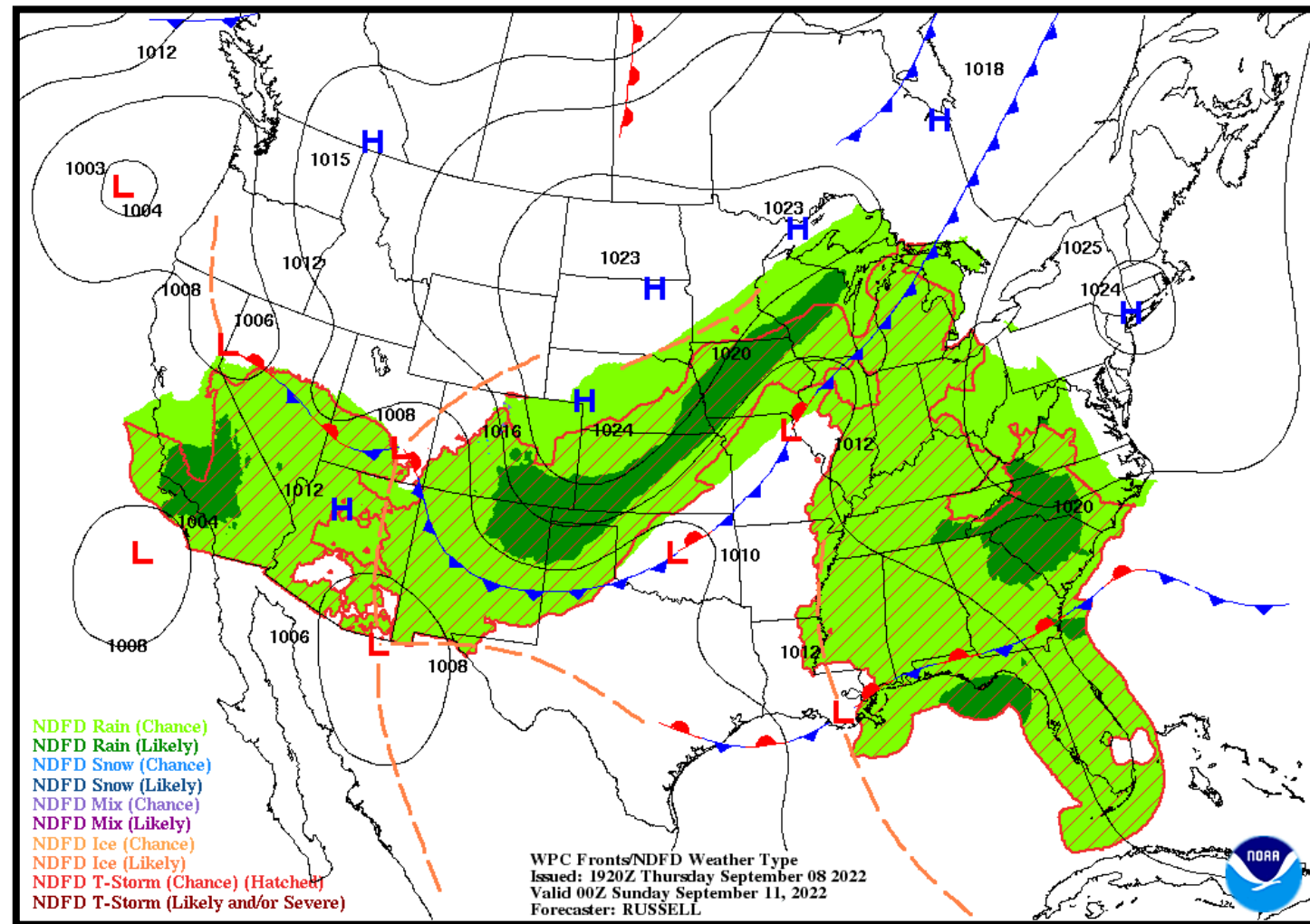
