


**Orleans Parish Severe Hail Events


5/8/1995 – A severe storm produced strong winds that damaged 20 light aircraft at Lakefront Airport. Several houses and businesses were heavily damaged by wind gusts throughout the New Orleans area from the Uptown and Garden District areas as well as the lakefront area and into east New Orleans. The storm produced an estimated \$750K in damage.

2/6/2008 – A line of strong to severe thunderstorms moved through the New Orleans metro area ahead of a strong cold front. One of the severe storms produced hurricane force (64 kt) wind gusts at Lakefront Airport.



2/13/2007 – Isolated supercells developed across southeast LA well in advance of a squall line and cold front. One of the supercells spawned a tornado that crossed the Mississippi River from Jefferson Parish and moved on a northerly course through portions of the Uptown and Carrollton areas, continuing into Mid City. A second tornado touched down near the Pontchartrain Park area and moved toward the Industrial Canal. Both tornadoes caused significant damage to both homes and commercial structures – removing roofs from several buildings. In total, the tornadoes destroyed 32 houses and damaged 295 others across Orleans Parish, causing a combined \$3M in damage. Additionally, 15 people suffered minor injuries and the second tornado caused one fatality when a travel trailer was destroyed, killing its 86 year old occupant. Both tornadoes were rated F2s.

3/10/1971 – A supercell storm spawned a tornado that initially touched down near the intersection of Veterans Blvd and West End Blvd. The tornado then moved eastward, through Lakeview causing an estimated \$2.5M in damage along its one mile path.
