The tornado touched down at 6:36 pm EDT on the Westwood Shopping Plaza ripping off roofing materials and ventilation units. It traveled northeast through a residential area uprooting and topping trees and causing roofing damage. The tornado passed just west of the Mercer Elementary School and adjacent Police Barracks ripping the roof off of an apartment building along Cowan Blvd and throwing it across the street. A law enforcement officer saw the tornado cross Cowan Blvd and then dissipate before it reached Mary Washington Hospital at 6:37 PM.
