After a cold front and any rain exited Arkansas to the east, winds shifted to the west and northwest and were gusty. Wind and Lake Wind Advisories were posted as gusts peaked from 40 to more than 50 mph.

At Newport (Jackson County), there was a 61 mph gust at 148 pm CST. A 49 mph gust was measured at Clinton (Van Buren County) and Stuttgart (Arkansas County), a 47 mph gust at Little Rock (Pulaski County), and a 46 mph gust at Russellville (Pope County). Roughly 11,000 power outages were blamed on the wind, and tree limbs were downed. Near Conway (Faulkner County), a section of fence was flattened.
