


Regional Climate Summary


January 2022

Arctic air settled into the region at the beginning of January. Temperatures fell well below normal from the 1st-3rd. Some locations received light snow or graupel, and other areas saw light rain showers. Temperatures warmed steadily into the middle of the month with the return of dry conditions. A strong cold front arrived on the 14th-15th accompanied by wind gusts over 50 mph and blowing dust. The roller coaster ride of temperatures continued through the end of the month with the passage of several more cold fronts. Another bout of winter weather occurred on the 26th when freezing drizzle brought a glaze of ice to northern portions of the area. In summary, January was cooler than normal and drought conditions continued to worsen.
