




NOAA, National Weather Service Middle Atlantic River Forecast Center Briefing

Noon – October 03, 2015

Key Messages

- Moderate to major coastal flooding is expected in some areas through Monday.
 Impacts include beach erosion, high surf and dangerous rip currents.
- The threat of river and small stream flooding has ended. Some rivers will experience rises of 1-3 feet over the next couple of days.


Rain on the Ground




Past 24 hour rainfall 1-3 inches across most of the south and east.


Forecast Precipitation

Day 1: Oct 3, 8am to Oct 4, 8 am






Day 2: Oct 4, 8am to Oct 5, 8 am




Areas of showers today and tomorrow with 48 hour rainfall amounts of a half inch or less.

3 Day River Forecasts


- No river flooding is predicted for the next several days.
- Some rivers will rise 2-3 feet today through Monday.
- Rainfall during the past 24 hours was less than expected in most areas.
- Additional rainfall today will be 0.25 inches or less in most areas.
- Moderate to major coastal flooding is expected in some areas through Monday.
