



# Minor Flooding Forecast Moderate Flooding Possible

**Decision Support Briefing #1** 

As of 12:00pm EST, February 23, 2018



#### What Has Changed?

✓ Confidence in minor flooding forecasts has increased







HAZARD:	Minor River Flooding Forecast/Moderate Flooding Possible
IMPACTS:	Minor flooding is forecast for two locations. Though not predicted at this time, additional forecast locations could also see minor flooding develop, depending on how the storm plays out. There is a limited chance that some locations could see moderate flooding develop before the end of the weekend, again depending on how the storm plays out.
LOCATION:	Williamsburg, PA and Beech Creek Station, PA are forecast to reach minor flooding. The Juniata Basin and West Branch of the Susquehanna have seen 0.5-1+ inches of rain in the past 48 hours and an additional 1.5-2+ inches is expected through Sunday.
TIMING:	Rain will continue through today, taper off some on Saturday, but heavier rain is expected to return Saturday evening into Sunday. Flooding is most like to occur Sunday morning into Monday.
CONFIDENCE:	Medium for minor flooding. Low for moderate flooding.
NOTES:	This briefing primarily covers river flooding. There is an additional risk of small stream flooding as well as urban and other poor drainage flooding.



## **Observed Precipitation**



 Precipitation during the 48 hours ending at 9am EST totaled 0.5-1+ inches across portions of NY, PA, NJ, and MD.










## **MARFC** Forecast Precipitation




- Three day rainfall totals of 1.5 - 2+ inches are forecast in the Central-Western portion of the Susquehanna Basin.
- Rain will continue through today, taper off some on Saturday, but heavier rain is expected to return Saturday evening into Sunday.







#### Water Content of Snowpack



 Areas where the heaviest rain is expected have little to no snowpack; however, soils are wet due to recent rains.










### **Current MARFC River Forecasts**



- Forecasts account for recent rain, soil moisture, forecast rain, and snow pack.
- Minor flooding is forecast for Williamsburg, PA and Beech Creek Station, PA.










### **5 Day Flood Outlook**



 While we are currently only forecasting minor flooding, moderate flooding is possible depending how the storm plays out.










## Flood Watches & Warnings
