What Has Changed?

✓ Confidence in minor flooding forecasts has increased







HAZARD:	Minor River Flooding Forecast/Moderate Flooding Possible
IMPACTS:	With minor flooding forecast, there will be road closures and impacts to low lying areas. Those with property in flood prone areas should take steps mitigate loss due to flood conditions. Moderate flooding will impact homes and businesses.
LOCATION:	Minor flooding is expected across portions of the Juniata Basin in central Pennsylvania. Several creeks in the Harrisburg area may also flood. Near flood stage levels are forecast for the New York portion of the Susquehanna River Basin.
TIMING:	Flooding is expected to develop overnight and into Sunday morning. Rivers should be in the way down by Monday at most locations.
CONFIDENCE:	High for minor flooding. Moderate for moderate flooding.
NOTES:	This briefing primarily covers river flooding. There is an additional risk of small stream flooding as well as urban and other poor drainage flooding.










Observed Precipitation



 Precipitation over the last 24 hours has been heaviest across central Pennsylvania and the New York portion of the Susquehanna and Delaware River.










MARFC Forecast Precipitation



While there will be rainfall across our service area today, we are expecting a larger and more vigorous area of rainfall to spread into the Middle Atlantic area between 3am and Noon on Sunday. Flooding will likely develop around daybreak Sunday.












Current MARFC River Forecasts



 Forecasts account for recent rain, soil moisture, forecast rain, and snow pack.










5 Day Flood Outlook



 While we are currently only forecasting minor flooding, moderate flooding is possible depending how the storm plays out.










Flood Watches & Warnings
