Weather Summary

A MCS formed over the Midwestern U.S. on July 18, 1989. It produced heavy showers and thunderstorms as it slowly moved eastward. Rainbands from the storm began to enter the Mid-Atlantic on the afternoon of July 19. The system stalled and heavy rainfall continued for 2 days. Several locations throughout MARFC's forecast flooded as a result of the showers and thunderstorms.
