Weather Summary

A strong low pressure system and its frontal boundaries produced 0.5 to 1 inch of rain, daily, across parts of the Susquehanna Basin. The low pressure system formed over Alberta and slowly moved into the Mid-Atlantic on June 14. Rain showers persisted in the region for several days. The system finally exited the region on June 18.
