

NWS Memphis Severe Weather Briefing





- Bottom line up front: Parts of the Mid-South have been upgraded to a Moderate Risk (level 4/5) for the overnight period tonight
- Destructive winds (80+ MPH), very large hail (2+ inches), and strong tornadoes are possible with these storms overnight
- A Flood Watch is in effect for northwest TN for 1.5-2 inches of rainfall overnight with locally higher amounts
- Another round of strong to severe storms is possible in portions of north MS tomorrow evening (Marginal Risk, level 1/5)




Strong tornadoes possible




Timing of Storms


For the main overnight period – some storms may develop earlier





Time Series - Northeast AR











Time Series - West Tennessee











Time Series - Memphis








Time Series - North Mississippi





Move away from windows and secure loose items



WHAT TO DO



Have multiple ways to receive warnings


If a warning is issued, take shelter in an interior room

Very large hail (2+ inches) may injure people caught outdoors

Possible significant property damage to vehicles & structures

Stay away from windows and park your vehicle under cover Have a plan to take shelter if needed





Excessive Rainfall Outlook

Tonight

HIGHEST LOCAL RISK



Numerous flash floods *likely*

TIMING

Late tonight – early Thu morning



Localized and primarily affecting places that can experience rapid runoff with heavy rainfall




Mainly localized. Most vulnerable are urban areas, roads, and small streams



Numerous flash flooding events with significant events possible. Larger rivers could be affected



Severe, widespread flash flooding. Lives and property in great danger

Late afternoon / evening


PRIMARY THREATS

Long-lived, widespread and intense




Long-lived, very widespread and particularly intense












Key Takeaways


- Moderate Risk (4/5) overnight tonight, Marginal Risk (1/5) tomorrow evening
 - Destructive winds, very large hail, and strong tornadoes possible tonight
- Flood Watch in effect until tomorrow morning for 1.5-2" of rain
- The most likely/impactful period of severe weather is overnight tonight
 - Make sure your Watch/Warning reception method can wake you up




High confidence in storm coverage/intensity overnight Medium confidence in rainfall totals/flooding potential Low confidence in severe potential tomorrow



Be Prepared for Nighttime Tornadoes



Nighttime Severe Weather Safety



- Charge your devices in case power goes out
- Make a sheltering plan before you go to bed
- Make sure you have a way for warnings to wake you up
- Turn OFF Do Not Disturb on your cell phone
- Place a flashlight and batteries by your bed


