

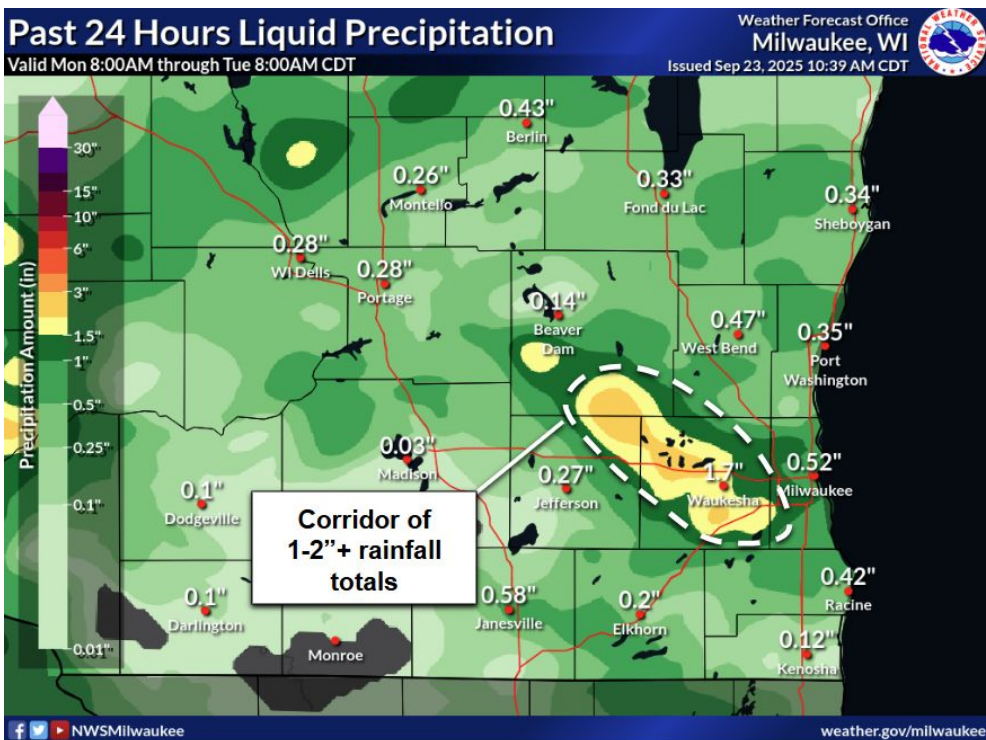


# September 22, 2025 Strong Storms

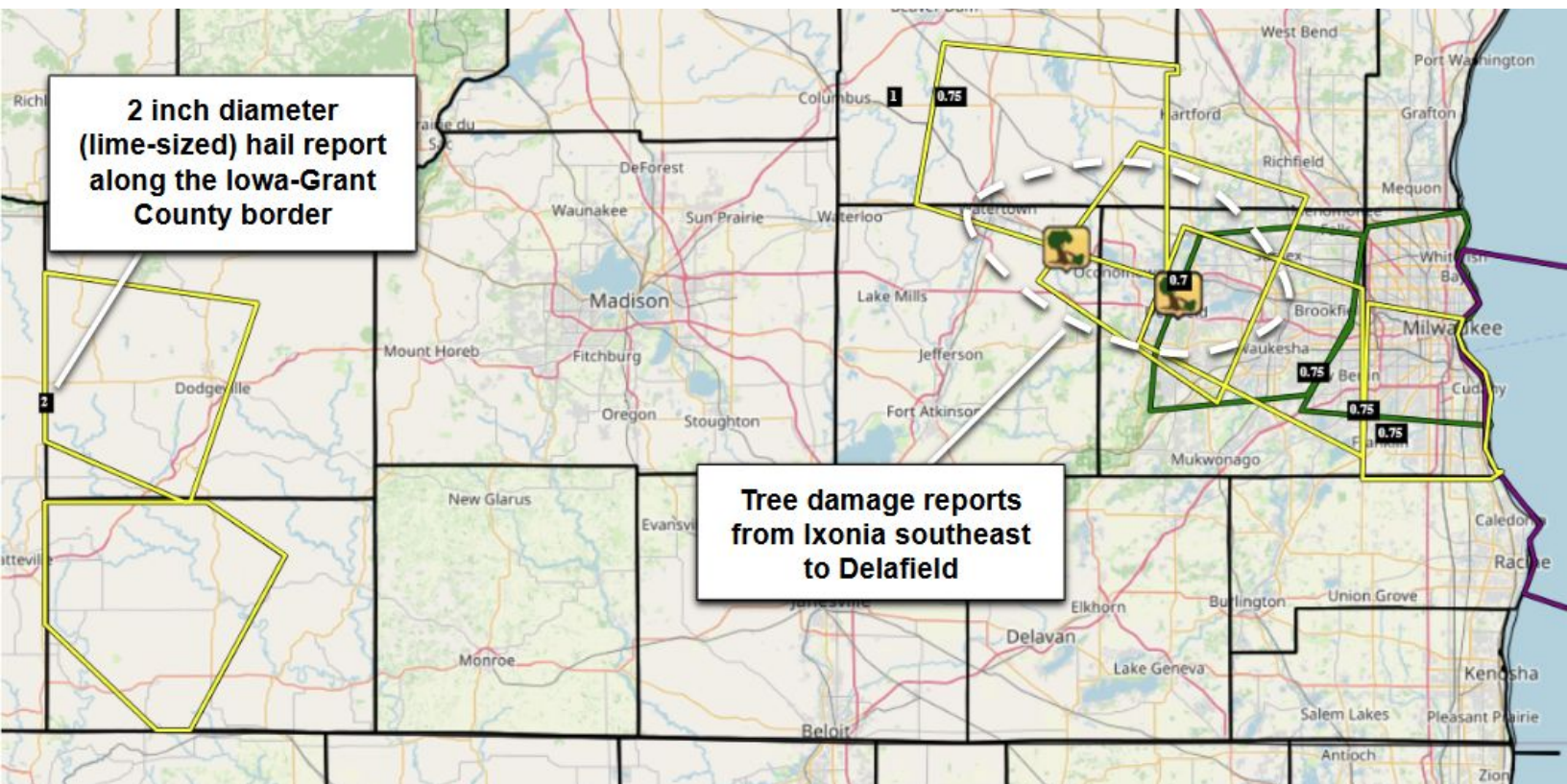
## Hail, Winds & Heavy Downpours In Southern Wisconsin

### Event Setup & Overview:

Scattered showers and storms developed along a slow moving cold front during the evening hours of September 22, 2025. Forming in a warm and unstable air mass, some of the storms became strong to severe as they tracked through portions of southwestern and southeastern Wisconsin. Several reports of tree damage were received from Ixonia southeast to Delafield. A storm tracking into Iowa County produced large hail up to the size of limes. Storms also produced torrential downpours, leading to minor street flooding over portions of the Milwaukee metro. Between 1-2 inches of rain fell in portions of Waukesha County.
