SURVEY SUMMARY: THIS WAS A CONTINUATION OF THE EF-4 HATTIESBURG TORNADO AS IT WAS WEAKENING AND CROSSING INTO PERRY COUNTY MISSISSIPPI. THE TORNADO WAS AS EF-1 STRENGTH AT 100 YARDS WIDE AS IT CROSSED THE COUNTY LINE THEN WEAKENED QUICKLY TO LESS THAN 80 YARDS WIDE AT EF-0 STRENGTH AS IT CROSSED CORINTH CHURCH ROAD JUST SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 42. THE TORNADO DISSIPATED JUST EAST OF CORINTH CHURCH ROAD IN A WOODED AREA.
