




Flood Potential Increases

- Time: April 13th – 17th
- Concerns: Significant warmup day/night
- Potential Significant Rainfall
- Higher Dewpoints
- Period of Wind
- Results: Significant snowmelt/flooding






Significant Snowmelt



- Time: April 11th – 17th
- Most Melt: Adirondacks...VT/NH..part of ME
- Snowpack temp and density increase
- Significant rainfall accompanies cold front
- Results: Significant snowmelt/flooding




Inches of water equivalent




Elevation in feet








Flood Potential Increases




- Time: April 13th – 17th
- High Temps and rapid Melt Forecast across snowpack
- Heavy Rainfall Potential : intensity...duration...and location forecasts need close monitoring the next few days for potential trigger to a significant flood event

- 0 Gauges: Major Flooding
- 0 Gauges: Moderate Flooding
- 4 Gauges: Minor Flooding
- 16 Gauges: Near Flood Stage
- 153 Gauges: No Flooding
- 10 Gauges: Forecasts older than 24 hours
- 23 Gauges: No forecast within selected timeframe
- 0 Gauges: Out of Service
