Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Timing
Heavy Snow (Winter Storm & Blizzard Warning in Effect)	 Dangerous travel conditions. Snowfall rates of 3"+/hr at times. White-out conditions at times across Long Island. Visibilities around ¼ mile or less at times elsewhere. 	This morning into the afternoon
Wind	 North winds 15-25 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Across Long Island: 20-30 mph with gusts 40-50 mph Blowing and Drifting Snow 	This morning into the afternoon
Temperatures	Dropping into the Mid-Upper 20s Thu Afternoon	This morning into the afternoon
Marine	N/NW wind gusts 35 to 45 knots on	

all nearshore waters.



Forecast Uncertainties

- Snowfall Amount Uncertainty
 - Location of the heaviest bands
 - Snow Ratios
 - Heavy wet snow before 8 a.m. becoming dry and powdery quickly thereafter.
