

MAJOR RIVER FLOODING IN SOUTHEAST ILLINOIS AND SOUTHWEST INDIANA

Widespread heavy rain, combined with snowmelt from December, produced major flooding on the White, Wabash, Little Wabash, and Patoka Rivers in early to mid January 2005. An old railroad bridge over the Wabash River just north of Interstate 64 partially collapsed due to the flooding.
