RIVER

EFFECTIVE FRIDAY, DECEMBER 12, 2014, THE NATIONAL WEATHER SERVICE (NWS) WILL INTRODUCE NEW
FLOOD CATEGORIES FOR THE WANAQUE FORECAST POINT (NWS - WNQN4, USGS # - 01387000).

WITH ASSISTANCE FROM LOCAL EMERGENCY MANAGERS AS WELL A FLOOD INUNDATION MAPPING PROJECT,
NEW FLOOD CATEGORIES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR WANAQUE (WNQN4).
