An upper level disturbance brought a prolonged period of light snow to the southern mountains and I-25 corridor. There were isolated heavy snow amounts...around 18 inches at the summit of Wolf Creek Pass (Mineral County)...and around Cuchara (Huerfano County). Other totals below widespread advisory criterion were..6 to 11 inches on the west side of Custer County near the Sangre de Cristo Mountains and near the Wet Mountains (Pueblo County)...and 3 to 7 inches in southwest El Paso County and eastern Fremont County.

Upslope flow...accompanied by abundant moisture brought heavy snow accumulations to the eastern San Juan Mountains and moderate accumulations to the La Garita Mountains and eastern Sawatch Range. The eastern Sawatch Range and La Garita Mountains received 5 to 10 inches of snow...and near the summit of Wolf Creek Pass (Mineral County) over a foot of snow fell.
