No structures were damaged or destroyed. The Purgatoire River acted as a nature fire break to the south and east. Approximately 125 firefighters from Fort Carson and the USFS helped to contain the blaze. On the 19th...thunderstorms with heavy rain overspread the area...helping to speed containment. The cost of fighting the fire came to \$2.8 million.</p>
