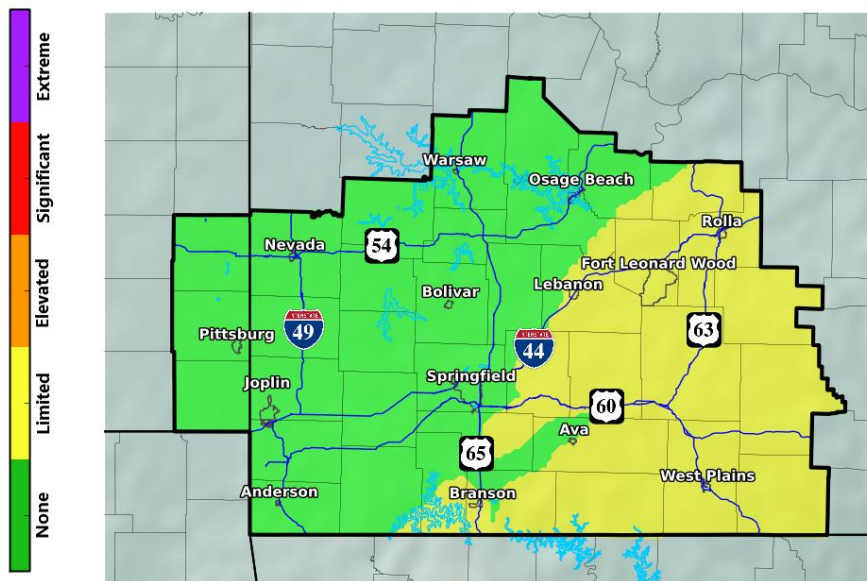


### A few strong storms possible this afternoon and evening

Thunderstorm wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph with the stronger storms.



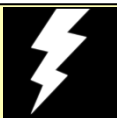
Hail of dime to quarter size for the stronger storms.



This afternoon and evening.

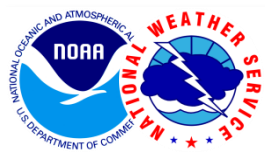


Areas mainly south and east of a Rolla to Branson line.



### Thunderstorm Outlook:

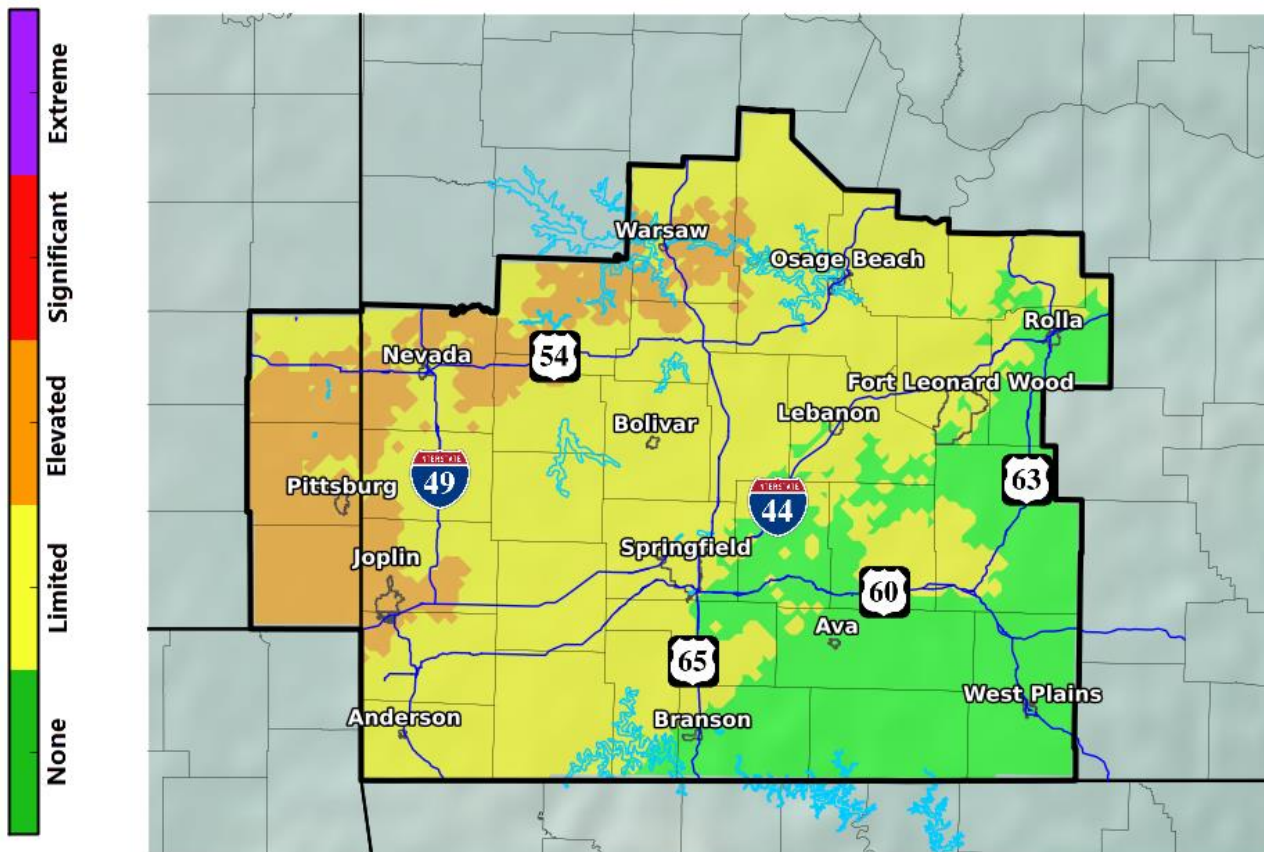
A cold front will push across the area today. Instability will develop ahead of the front this afternoon across the eastern Ozarks and some thunderstorms will be possible, mainly south and east of a Rolla to Branson line. If enough instability can develop, some strong storms will be possible with small hail and wind gusts up to 50 mph.

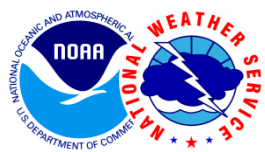
