The storms were initially multi-cellular in mode with a few embedded supercells, before transitioning into a mix of multicell clusters and line segments. The strongest line segment developed over north central Christian County and south central Greene County, which quickly moved to the northeast and bowed out. A leading notch was warned on for the potential for a tornado and a damage path coincided with this feature. Another second, very strong line segment moved through the Rolla area around 0430z, resulting in reports of power poles down and roof damage to an apartment complex.</p>
