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A winter storm brought heavy snow to much of the Missouri Ozarks with accumulations of 6 to 12 inches generally along and north of the Interstate 44 corridor. The highest accumulations of 10 to 12 inches occurred across portions of central Missouri east of Lebanon through the Rolla area. Northwest winds of 20 to 35 mph resulted in significant blowing and drifting snow along with bitterly cold wind chills.
