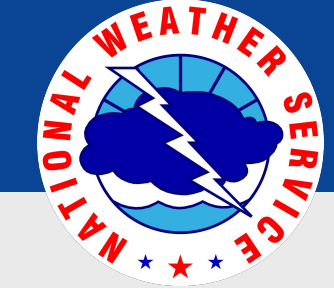

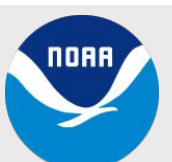

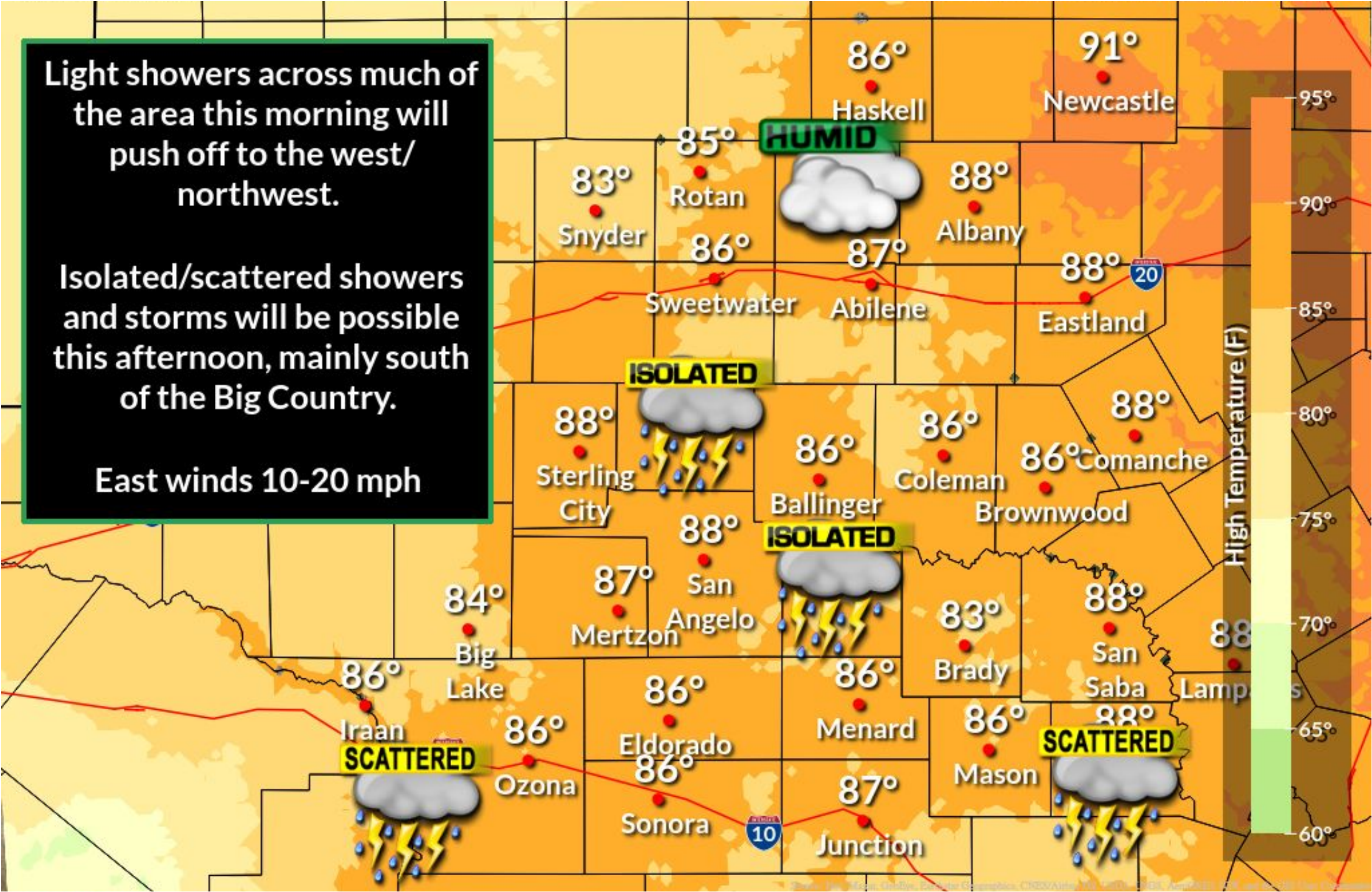

- Dry and trending hotter for the weekend with triple digit temperatures returning next week.

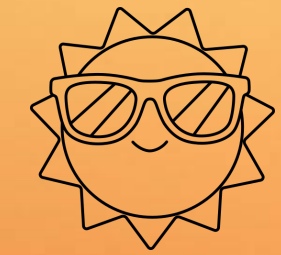
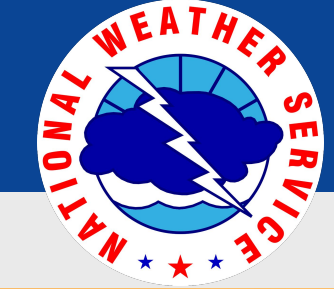

First Day of Astronomical Summer

- June 20th marks the first day of Summer. The last day of Summer is marked by the Fall Equinox, which is on September 22nd, 2024.
- The summer solstice is the longest day of the year, with over 14 hours of sunlight for our area.








During the summer solstice the Northern Hemisphere is at its maximum tilt towards the sun

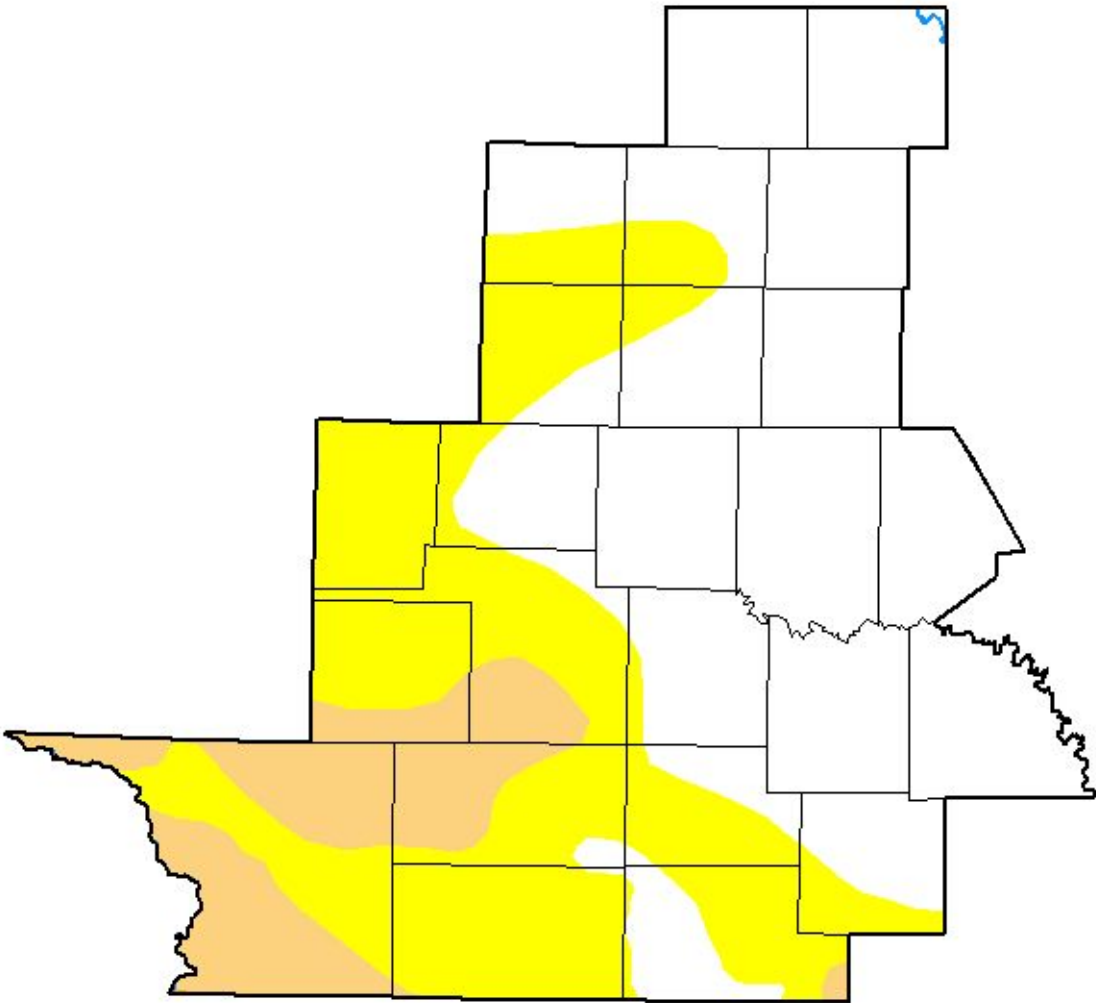

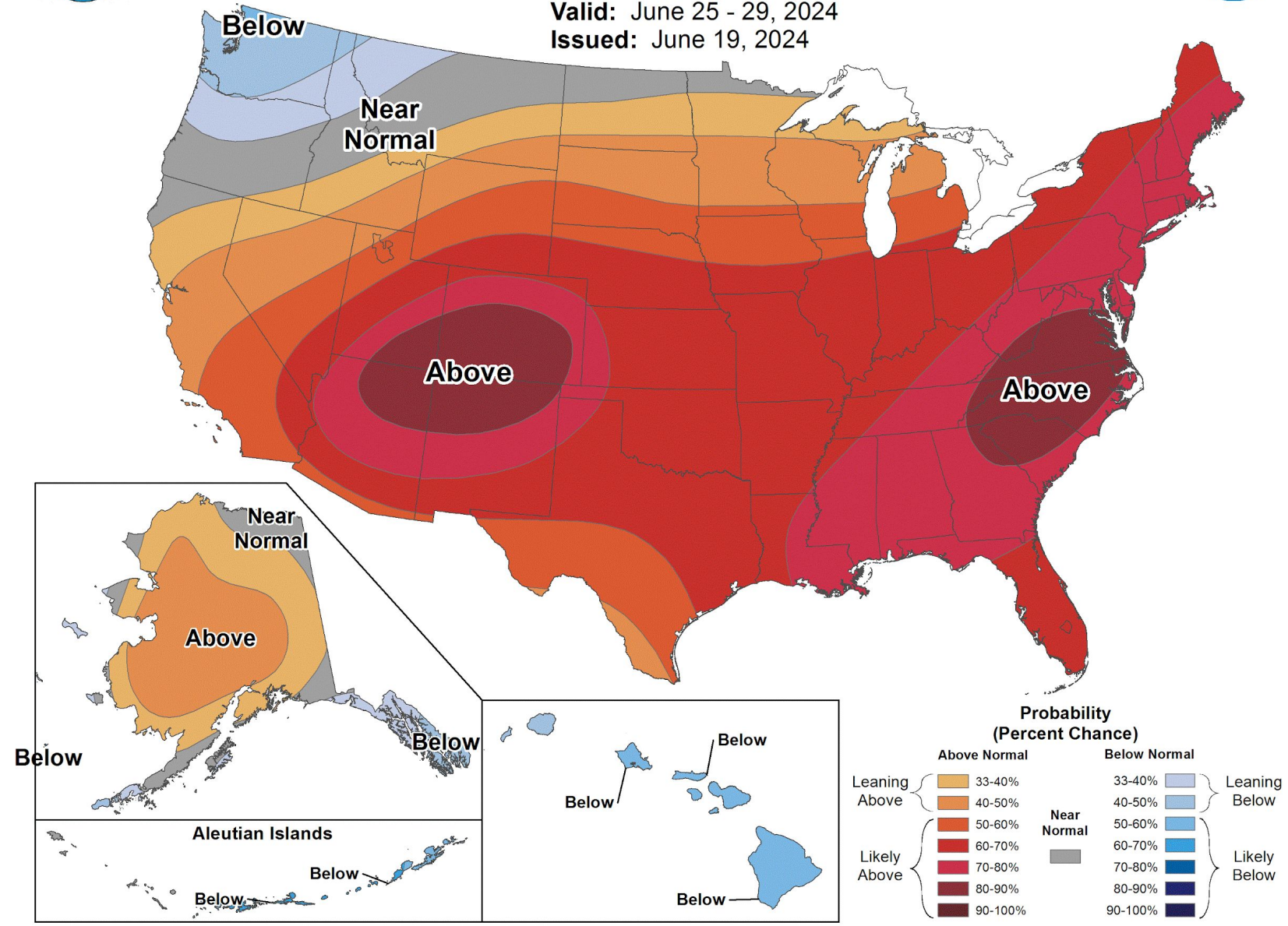

Issued: June 19, 2024

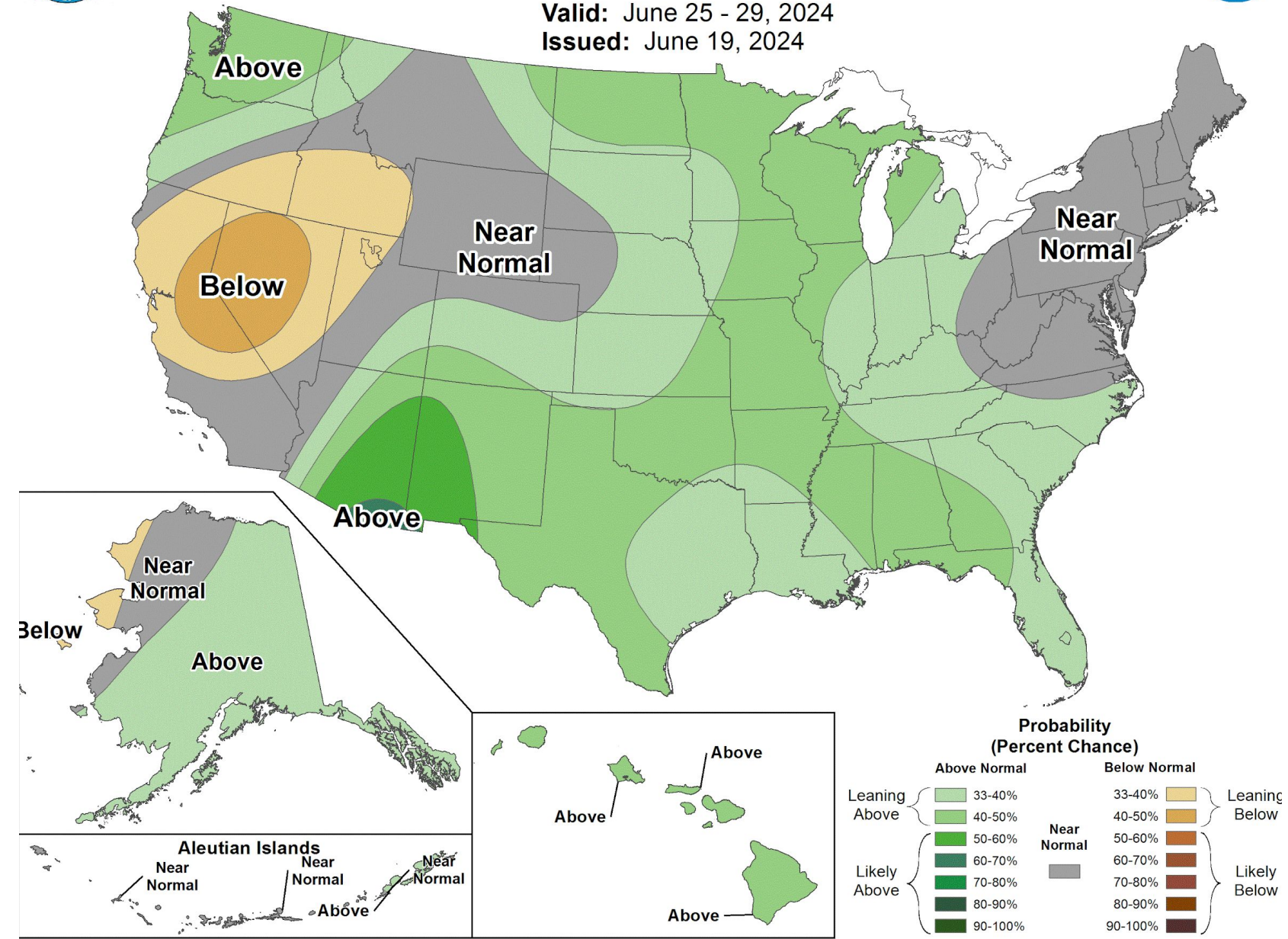


Normal Temperatures:

Issued: June 19, 2024



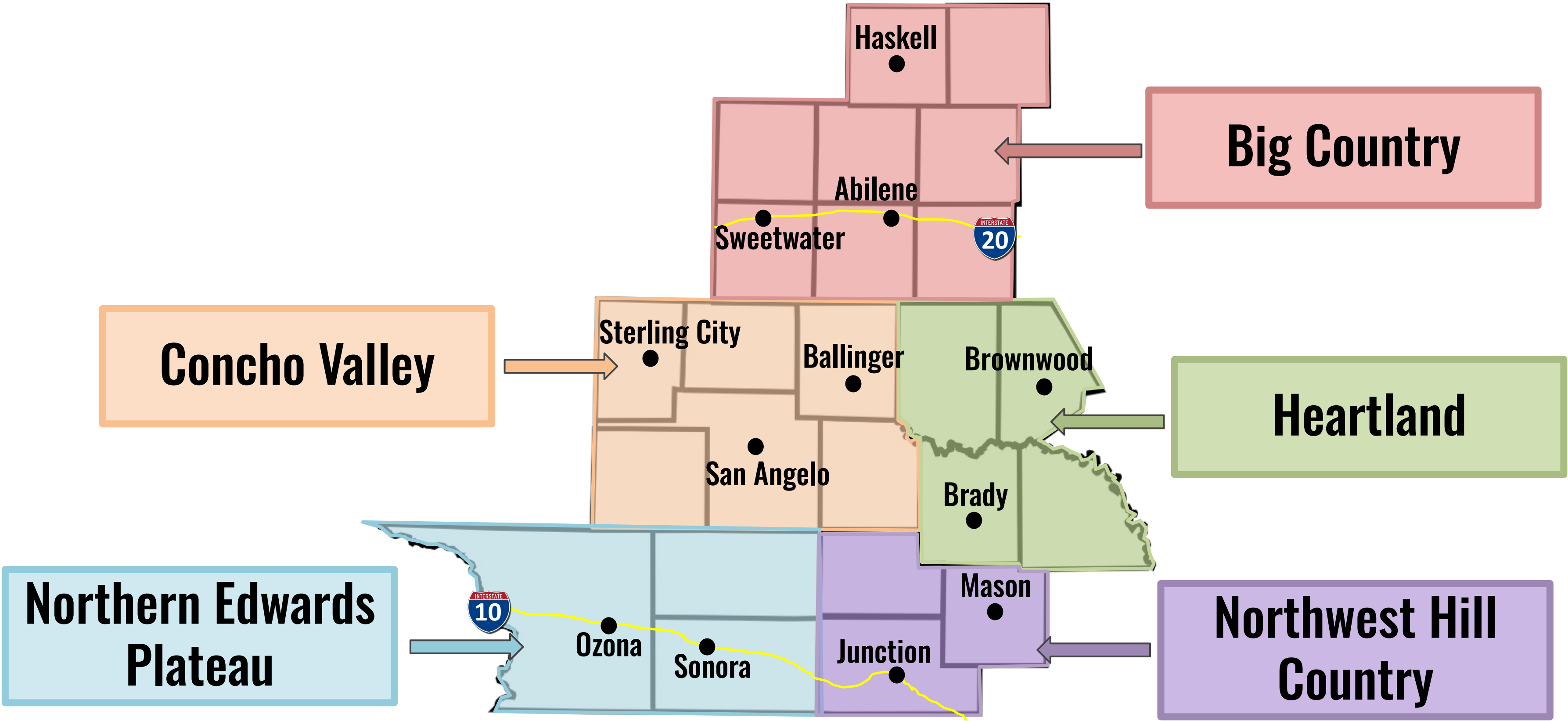
Normal Precipitation:
