

# Volunteer Opportunities in Fall 2022 with NWS Tallahassee



The National Weather Service in Tallahassee is offering the opportunity to work with forecasters in an operational environment **virtually** with the NWS Weather Forecast Office in Tallahassee in Fall 2022.

### **Minimum Qualifications:**

Currently enrolled at an University in pursuit of a meteorology degree (Freshmen class and above) or a graduate student in meteorology.

## **Application Process and Deadlines:**

Your application should include the following:

- \* A one page resume
- \* A cover letter up to one page
- \* An unofficial transcript
- \* Two essays (each limited to one page, unless specified otherwise)
- 1. Why does a career in operational meteorology interest you?
- 2. What do you feel is your greatest strength, and how do you think it will help you succeed in this volunteer position with NWS Tallahassee?

Applications are due by **email** to both (<u>eric.bunker@noaa.gov</u> and <u>kelly.godsey@noaa.gov</u>) no later than **3 pm on Friday, July 22nd** 

## What to expect:

Interviews will be held on **August 8th through August 17th Virtually via Google Hangout**. Selections will be made by **September 1st**. Volunteer work will begin virtually in early September (around the beginning of the Fall Semester).
