Summary Information:

No flood stage changes or impact statement adjustments were needed at this location following a review of impacts during Hurricane Irma.

Impact Statements:

31 ft Considerable flood damage to structures occurs within 1 mile of the Santa Fe and Ichetucknee Rivers.

29 ft Significant flooding continues. Access to areas within one half mile of the Santa Fe or Ichetucknee Rivers becomes impossible. Numerous homes, included those elevated, continue to flood.

28 ft Homes even with stilts near the river are prone to flooding throughout the area. Flood waters will approach River Run Road near 280th Street in Suwannee County. SW Nebraska Terrace in Columbia County floods.

26 ft Significant flooding continues throughout the area. Flooded area along the Ichetucknee River expands in both Suwannee and Columbia Counties. Numerous homes are flooded at this level.

24 ft Flooding expands across the area affecting numerous homes on Santa Fe Road and SW Riverside Avenue in Columbia County. Access to 29th loop in Suwannee County becomes restricted.

23 ft Homes are inaccessible along River Run Road in Suwannee County west of 33rd Road.

22 ft River Run Road at 29th Loop floods in Suwannee County. Santa Fe Road in Columbia County is inaccessible.

21 ft Homes are surrounded on River Run Road in Suwannee County. Structures flood along Santa Fe Road west of Idaho Parkway in Suwannee County.

20 ft Access to homes on Santa Fe Road below SW Riverside Avenue becomes restricted in Columbia County. Flooding begins on Santa Fe and Wilson Springs Road.

19.8 ft Waters begins to affect homes in the Hollingsworth Bluff area at State Route 47.

19.0 ft Water begins to enter backyards of residences along the Ichetucknee River

18.75 ft Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission expands the no wake zone restriction further upstream on the Santa Fe River from the unnamed island 1.5 miles downstream on the Wilson's Spring Boat Ramp to one-half mile upstream of the State Road 47 bridge.

18 ft Water begins to flood River Run Road in Suwannee County.

17 ft Water begins to enter backyards of residences on Santa Fe Road in Columbia County and on River Run Road in Suwannee County.

16.25 ft Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission begins enforcement of a no wake zone on the Santa Fe River from the unnamed island 1.5 miles downstream of the Wilson's Spring Boat Ramp to the confluence with the Suwannee River and on the Ichetucknee River upstream to the US 27 bridge.

16 ft Lowland flooding begins on SW Santa Fe Drive south of Santa Fe Road in Columbia County.
