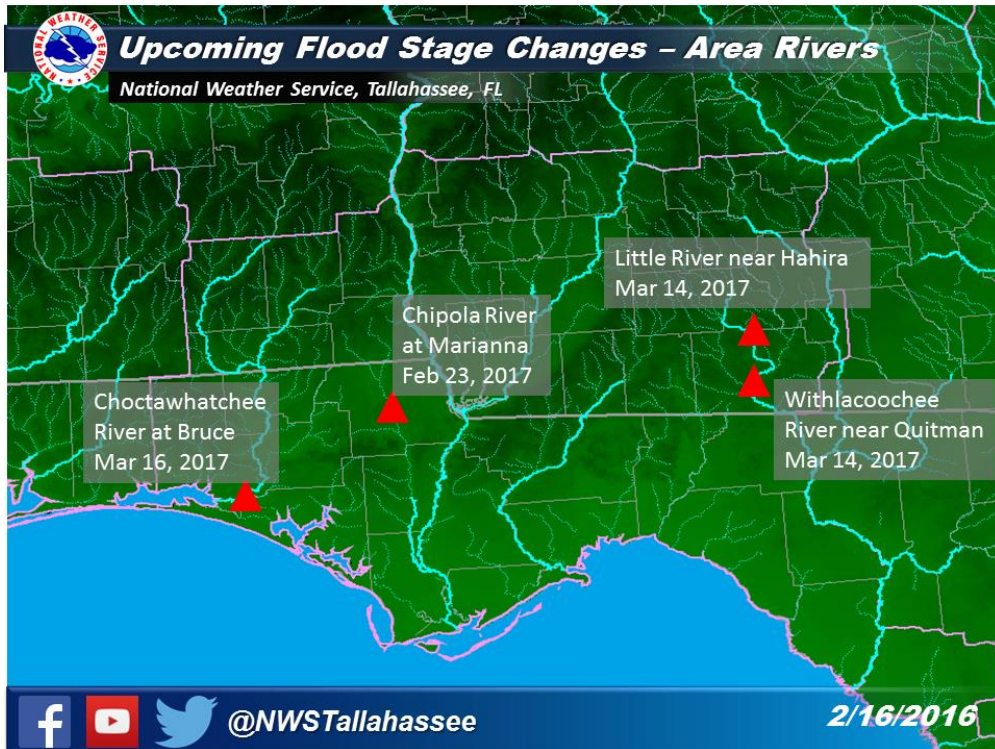

Upcoming Enhancements to the Hydrology Program

Sites Affected



From late February into mid March, several enhancements to the hydrology program are planned. Two new sites will begin receiving river forecast services in South Central Georgia in the Withlacoochee Basin.

Flood stages will also be slightly modified at these locations to address recent feedback from local emergency management.

In the Florida Panhandle, extensive reviews have been completed of past flood events and the results of these studies are being applied to the Chipola River at Marianna and the Choctawhatchee River at Bruce. These flood stage improvements are designed to better communicate the level of impact from future river floods.
