

## 2016 Summer Student Intern Announcement for CWSU Nashua

The National Weather Service's (NWS) Center Weather Service Unit (CWSU) in Nashua NH is now accepting applications for our Volunteer Summer Student Intern Program. The CWSU is located at the Federal Aviation Administration's (FAA) Air Route Traffic Control Center in Nashua NH. Application packages will be accepted until 400 pm on Friday March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2016. A maximum of three (3) positions will be available this year. These are unpaid positions.

### ***Background:***

- This volunteer program gives students the opportunity to learn about NWS careers by gaining on-the-job experience.
- Students can earn academic credit if approved by their academic institution.

### ***Eligibility:***

- Undergraduate students majoring in meteorology (or any of the physical sciences), or graduate students with a background in meteorology.
- You must be an enrolled student over the summer of 2016.
- Applicants must be U.S. citizens and are required to complete security and background investigations for both the FAA and the NWS.

### ***Volunteer Duties:***

- Shadow forecasters on the job and learn and perform the basic briefing duties of the CWSU.
- Work on a project that has some operational or training utility to the CWSU. Specific projects will be discussed with the selectees after they begin their internship.
- Job shadows with the NWS Weather Forecast Office and Northeast River Forecast Center, both in Taunton MA.

### ***How to Apply:***

- Applications should consist of a letter of interest, a resume which highlights your skills and interests in meteorology, and a copy of your latest college transcript.

- Applicants will be selected based on a combination of the application package, references, coursework and a potential phone interview.
- We anticipate making our selections by Friday April 1<sup>st</sup>, in order to ensure enough time to complete security clearances in a timely fashion.
