Summary: The Marine Reporting Stations (MARS) effort is outlined in U.S. Coast Guard Commandant Instruction 3140.3D (COMDINST 3140.3D), published 13 Jan 1988. This directive outlines certain aspects of weather observation reporting that are already outlined in the COMDINST 3140.3D. Furthermore, although there are still a few "MARS" stations in several regions, this instruction does not properly capture the full programmatic requirements for these stations.
